### ANNUAL BRUSH INSPECTION NOTICE

Dear Resident:

This is the first notice of inspection and a reminder that fire department personnel will be performing brush inspections on your property to comply with the municipal code regarding vegetation. Please visit the City's website, [www.cityofmonrovia.org](http://www.cityofmonrovia.org), and click on the fire department link for resources on the brush clearance program.

#### **Annual brush inspections will begin on or after Saturday, June 15, 2024**

Please complete all required work prior to this date. If compliance is not obtained, your property may be subject to potential re-inspection fees. Higher administrative fines will be imposed for hazardous conditions requiring abatement. Severe violations that pose an imminent threat to health and safety may be forwarded to the City Prosecutor.

To assist residents with brush disposal, the City has once again partnered with Athens Services to provide roll-off bins and bulky item pick-ups free of charge from May 1 to July 31. Please refer to the enclosed "Brush Disposal Options" document for further details. As a reminder, be certain to take the proper safety precautions regarding brush removal and disposal. The enclosed flyer related to the safe use of equipment can be used as a guideline.

The City of Monrovia is a National Ready, Set, Go Wildfire Preparedness Program member. The tenets of the program are:

- Ready** – Preparing for the Fire Threat
- Set** – Situational Awareness when a Fire Starts
- Go** – Early Evacuation

Please take the time to review the included "Residential Safety Checklist."
