BRUSH DISPOSAL OPTIONS FOR 2024

Brush Clearance Program – Debris Disposal Options

Disposal of clippings and cuttings generated during brush clearance is the homeowner's responsibility.

To better assist with your debris disposal, please consider the following options:

1. LARGE AMOUNTS OF BRUSH

Please call Monrovia Fire & Rescue Brush Hotline at **626-256-8109** to inquire about roll-off bin services. Bins will be provided free of charge from **MAY 1 to July 31, 2024**. Residents are responsible for loading the bins with cleared brush. This complimentary service is **ONLY** for cleared brush in the **VERY HIGH FIRE HAZARD SEVERITY ZONE (VHFHSZ)** and **NOT** for general household waste.

- ▶ Monrovia Fire Personnel will coordinate with Athens Services to have a bin delivered.
- ▶ **Bins should be ordered minimum of 48 hours prior to the date of use.**
- ▶ Encroachment permits for the bins are waived for brush disposal from May 1 to July 31, 2024.
- ▶ Available bins range from a 3 cubic yard bin to a 40 cubic yard roll-off.

2. MEDIUM AMOUNTS OF BRUSH

Please contact Athens Services at 888-336-6100 to schedule a Bulky Item pick-up. The debris should fill a space no greater than 4 feet by 6 feet. Bushes and branches must be:

- ▶ Cut and tied in bundles no longer than 4 feet in length.
- ▶ Weigh less than 50 pounds.
- ▶ Extra pick-ups are available for an additional charge (inquire with Athens Services).

3. SMALL AMOUNTS OF BRUSH

Please place debris in your green materials barrel. This includes items such as grass clippings, tree trimmings, leaves, brush, branches, limbs and other organic material generated from your garden. Do not place the following items in your barrels:

- ▶ Stumps or branches exceeding 3 inches in diameter or 3 feet in length.
- ▶ No palm fronds, yucca leaves or bamboo.
- ▶ No dirt, rocks or trash.

4. SOURCE REDUCTION

Please consider vegetation management, backyard composting, and plant selection to reduce organic materials on your property.
