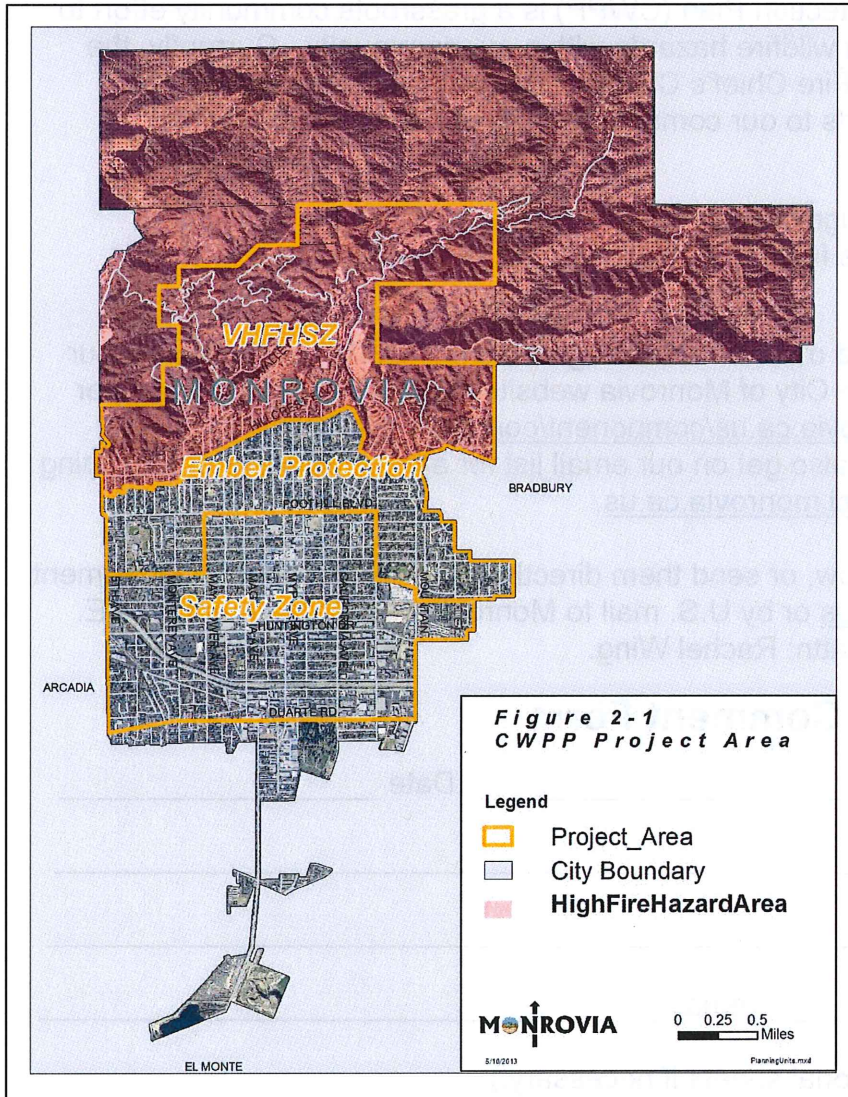

Q & A About Monrovia's CWPP



What is a CWPP?

A CWPP is a Community Wildfire Protection Plan, a guiding document for future actions developed by a community in an area at-risk from wildland fire. The plan must:

- ✚ Be collaboratively developed
- ✚ Address structural ignitibility
- ✚ Propose projects to reduce fuels

How will Monrovia benefit?

- ✚ Public Education; Sustainability
- ✚ Cost-Effectiveness; Grant Eligibility
- ✚ Community Engagement

What areas are affected?

1. High Fire Hazard Zone.
2. Ember Zone that can be threatened by flying embers.
3. Safety Zone, providing staging and evacuation areas, in the event of a major wildfire.

What is Monrovia doing to develop a CWPP?

The Fire Department initiated a series of public meetings beginning in September, 2012 and has formed a Fire Chief's CWPP Advisory Group of volunteer community members assisting department staff. Meetings are ongoing and **you** are invited!
