## Animals

### Adopt a Pet

Thousands of dogs, cats and other critters are available for adoption each year. Add a furry friend to your family and save the life of a homeless pet. Visit the shelter or view photos of adoptable pets on the PHS website.

### Be a Responsible Pet Parent

Get your pet spayed or neutered and keep vaccines up to date. PHS can help you with low-cost options. Always keep an updated ID tag and license on your pet! Follow all the ownership laws in your community. And, don't forget to keep your dog on leash in public areas or safely confined on your property at all times.

## Report Animal Cruelty

If you suspect an animal is being harmed, contact animal control. PHS officers investigate animal cruelty in our animal control contract cities to ensure a humane community.
