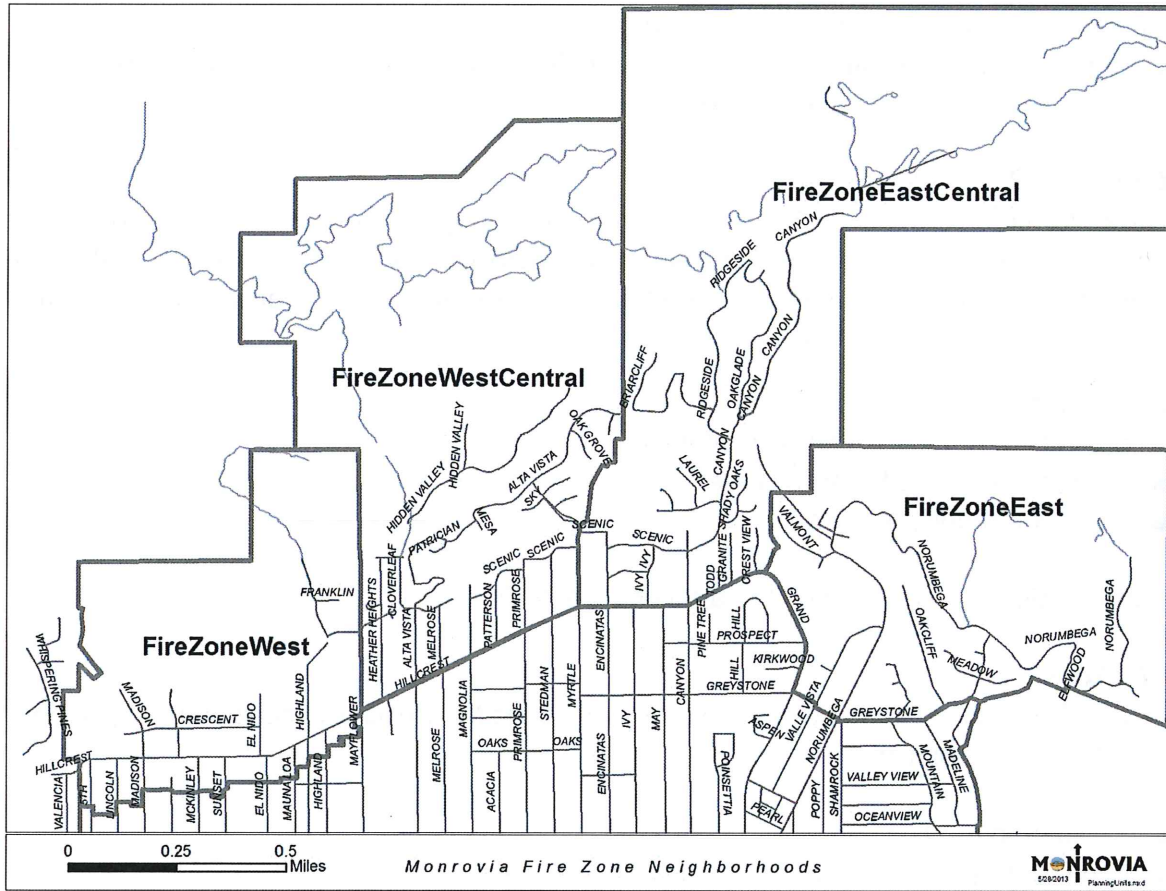

What is a CWPP?

Monrovia's Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP) is a grassroots community effort to strategize our approach to living with wildfire. We need you to help identify the assets that you value in your community that are at risk from wildfire and help come up with actions that we can take to mitigate those risks. Strategies can include:

- ✚ public education programs
- ✚ projects to reduce structural ignitability
- ✚ projects to reduce hazardous fuels
- ✚ other community actions

What is Nixle?

Nixle is an emergency communication system that will let Monrovia residents choose how they prefer to receive information such as:

- ✚ Evacuation notifications
- ✚ Red Flag Days
- ✚ Wildlife alerts
- ✚ Etc.
