TITLE: Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for December 2017

OBJECTIVE: To provide an update on incidents, maintenance, and public comments related to Canyon Park and the Hillside Wilderness Preserve (HWP) recorded for the month of December 2017.

BACKGROUND: For over a century, Canyon Park has been used as a recreational park by visitors and Monrovia residents. Services in Canyon Park include special events; Naturalist led night hikes, interpretive tours, a Nature Center, trails, a waterfall, and views of the San Gabriel Valley. In addition, Naturalists, with the support of many volunteers that maintain the trail system and facilities.

In 2016, the City opened over 4.5 miles of HWP trials providing passive recreational opportunities for the community. Park Naturalists patrol the HWP as well as urban parks two times a day by vehicle, utility terrain vehicle, and foot. Park Naturalists also respond to calls related to Monrovia's No Smoking Ordinance.

The included HWP and Canyon Park Log provide additional information related to the Comments, Maintenance, Incidents, and Events which occurred in December 2017.

ANALYSIS: During the month of December, the Park Naturalists completed 127 hours of maintenance throughout the Hillside Wilderness Preserve and 72 hours in Canyon Park. The maintenance included brush clearance, the installation of steps into the steep areas of the Cloverleaf Access Point Trail, the removal of fallen trees, fence repairs, and removal of invasive species. The Park Naturalists assisted with two City events, the first was the Julian Park Dedication and the second was the New Year's Eve Event on Myrtle. The Park Naturalist also assisted Fire and PD with the evacuation of residents during the Norembega Fire on December 9.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Community Services Commission move to receive and file CC-2, Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for December 2017.
