TITLE: Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for April 2018

OBJECTIVE: To provide an update on incidents, maintenance, and public comments related to Canyon Park and the Hillside Wilderness Preserve (HWP) recorded for the month of April 2018.

BACKGROUND: For over a century, Canyon Park has been used as a recreational park by visitors and Monrovia residents. Services in Canyon Park include special events; Naturalist led night hikes, interpretive tours, a Nature Center, trails, a waterfall, and views of the San Gabriel Valley. In addition, Naturalists, with the support of many volunteers that maintain the trail system and facilities.

In 2016, the City opened over 4.5 miles of HWP trials providing passive recreational opportunities for the community. Park Naturalists patrol the HWP as well as urban parks two times a day by vehicle, utility terrain vehicle, and foot. Park Naturalists also respond to calls related to Monrovia's No Smoking Ordinance.

The included HWP and Canyon Park Log provide additional information related to the Comments, Maintenance, Incidents, and Events which occurred in April 2018.

ANALYSIS: During the month of April 2018, Park Naturalists completed 106 hours of maintenance throughout the Hillside Wilderness Preserve and 174 hours in Canyon Park. The maintenance included brush clearance around park facilities, hiking trails, and utility roads, invasive species removal, and trail erosion prevention. Programs for April included the completion the Second Grade Education tours, and the start of Kindergarten programs for Monrovia Elementary Schools. Park Naturalists assisted in Los Angeles County's Ecology Fair held on April 21; Mayflower Elementary School's Fundraiser Carnival held on April 28; and Kids Craft in the Canyon held on Saturday, April 29.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Community Services Commission move to receive and file CC-2, Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for April 2018.
