PH-1 Appeal of a Decision of the Development Review Committee for Neighborhood Compatibility

Design Review

DR2018-0005 (Appeal APL2018-001)

239 North Alta Vista Avenue; Applicant, Alan and Kathryn Morse

**Request:** Appeal the decision of the Development Review Committee approving a Neighborhood Compatibility Design Review for the construction of a new 3,628 square foot two-story, single-family residence on a 9,720 square foot lot in the RL (Residential Low) zone. This project is Categorically Exempt (Class 3) from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

Recommendation: Deny the appeal and uphold the Development Review Committee's decision regarding Neighborhood Compatibility Review DR2018-0005

PH-2 Ordinance No. 2018-03; Planning Commission Resolution No. PCR2018-03 Applicant, City of Monrovia

**Request:** Amendment to the Monrovia Municipal Code, amending Title 17 (Zoning) to provide regulation and approval requirements for Tattoo Establishments in the CRS/RCC, RCM, M, and HCD Zoning Districts.

Recommendation: Adopt Planning Commission Resolution No. PCR2018-03

PH-3 Station Square South Specific Plan TPM 78225, CUP2018-0008, SP2018-0001, MCA2018-0001, and GPC2018-0001

Applicant, Richman Group of California

**Request:** The Station Square South Specific Plan is a plan for a 3.79-acre (gross) property adjacent to the Monrovia Gold Line Station that proposes a transit-oriented, 5-story multi-family residential development of 296 dwelling units, including 6 live/work units. The project includes three private courtyards, a public open space area along South Magnolia Avenue, and a 6-story (seven-level) parking structure. The project also proposes to change Peck Road north of Duarte Road to a publicly accessible driveway and drop-off area for the adjacent Metro Gold Line Station. This property is located in the PD-12 (Planned Development Area 12 – Station Square Transit Village) zone.

The proposed project includes adoption of the Station Square South Specific Plan, approval of Tentative Parcel Map (TPM) No. 78225 to consolidate several parcels into one parcel, adoption of a

Zoning Ordinance and Map Amendment to add Station Square South Specific Plan to both the Zoning Map and to Section 17.04.035 of the Monrovia Municipal Code, a General Plan Conformity finding that the vacation of a public street (Peck Road) is in conformance with the provisions of the General Plan, and approval of a Conditional Use Permit to construct the development (collectively, the "proposed project").

Recommendation: Adopt Planning Commission Resolution Nos. PCR2018-0001, PCR2018-0002, and PCR2018-0003, recommending approval of the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, Zoning Ordinance Map and Text Amendment Ordinance No. 2018-04, Station Square South Specific Plan, find that the proposed street vacation and dedication of easements are in conformity with the General Plan, and recommend approval of TPM 78225 and CUP2018-0008 as presented in the Staff Report.
