# 1. Req. #2015-188: Gold Line – Mayflower and Central Aves – Safety

# 2. Mayflower Ave and Huntington Dr

Preliminary plans were discussed at the December 17, 2015, meeting. Intersection is currently being evaluated by Gibson Transportation Consulting, Inc. for the readjustment of lane lines. Committee to review signal timing. DO NOT BLOCK INTERSECTION signage installed on November 16, 2017, for north and southbound traffic.

#### 2. Req. #2016-026: North and South Mayflower Ave (from Huntington Dr) - Safety

Resident requesting to refresh street striping on north and south Mayflower from Huntington and/or to add raised pavement markers. Intersection is currently being evaluated by Gibson Transportation Consulting, Inc. for the re-adjustment of lane lines. DO NOT BLOCK INTERSECTION signage installed on November 16, 2017, for north and southbound traffic. *Cross-referenced with Req. #2015-188 and Req. #2017-054.* 

# 3. Req. #2017-039: Mayflower and Olive Aves (Monroe Elementary) – Traffic / Safety

2. Resident requesting blue ADA curb / parking at the Mayflower and Olive intersection, at Monroe Elementary.

Current blue ADA curb on the north-west corner of Alta Vista and Olive.

#### 4. <u>Req. #2017-047: 600 block of West Olive Ave (north side) – Speeding / Traffic /</u> Parking

Resident requesting a speed study, traffic calming, and the evaluation of limited street parking due to street sweeping and trash pick-up days, on the 600 block of W Olive.

# 5. <u>Req. #2017-050: 103 East Altern Ave (at Peck Rd) – Speeding / Traffic / Safety (red curbing)</u>

Resident requesting a speed study and traffic calming, and red curbing at the north side of the driveway apron, for line-of-site traffic safety, on Peck at Altern.

#### 6. <u>Req. #2017-053: North Canyon Blvd (north of Foothill Blvd) – Speeding / Traffic /</u> <u>Safety</u>

Resident requesting a speed study and traffic calming on N Canyon. Cross-referenced with Req. #2017-010 – Closed.

# 7. Reg. #2018-002: 219 West Olive Ave – Speeding / Traffic / Safety

Resident requesting a speed study and traffic calming on W Olive.

#### 8. <u>Req. #2018-020: 790 Oakglade Drive (No Parking Except by Permit Only (END)</u> <u>signage) – Parking</u>

Resident requesting to have the No Parking Except by Permit Only (END) signage moved to the north of her property and around the curve of 800 Oakglade. This signage is to deter Canyon Park visitors from parking in the residential neighborhood.

#### 9. <u>Req. #2018-022: Mayflower Ave and Huntington Dr Walgreens Signage / Myrtle</u> <u>Ave and 210 Fwy Signage / Foothill Blvd and Madison Ave Starbucks – Traffic /</u> <u>Safety</u>

- 4. Resident requesting enforcement of the double yellow line restriction at the Starbucks at Foothill and Madison.
  - a. There is a slight break in the double yellow line on the south side at the Starbucks drive through exit.

Cross-referenced with Req. #2015-188, #2016-026, and Req. #2017-054.

#### 10. Req. #2018-023: Highway Safety Improvement Plan – Traffic / Safety

Signal installation at Foothill and California, Foothill and Sunset, and intersection modifications at Huntington and Fifth, with Caltrans grant funding.

#### 11. Req. #2018-024: Blue ADA Curb Application and Policy and Procedure – Parking

To establish a blue ADA curb application and policy and procedure for a resident requesting to have a blue ADA curb installed at their residence and assessing the path of travel.

#### 12. Req. #2018-027: 632 Norumbega Dr (street sweeping) – Parking

Resident requesting property and right-of-way delineation street markings for street parking and street sweeping restrictions.

#### 13. Req. #2018-028: Foothill Blvd and El Nido Ave (red curbing) – Traffic / Safety

Resident requesting red curbing on the north-east corner (on El Nido) for line-of-site safety to make a right turn onto El Nido from westbound Foothill and extend the red curbing on the south-west corner (on Foothill) for line-of-site safety when making a right turn onto Foothill from southbound El Nido.

#### Req. #2018-029: 849 West Duarte Road / Mon Arc Manor – Traffic / Safety Resident requesting red curbing or a loading zone in front of the complex for line-of-site

safety when exiting the driveway.

 <u>Req. #2018-030: Park Rose and Orange Aves (speed cushions) – Speeding</u> Resident requesting a speed study and traffic calming on Park Rose and Orange, in a school zone.

#### 16. Reg. #2018-031: 335 West Walnut Ave (speed cushions) - Speeding

Resident requesting a speed study and traffic calming on the 300 block of W Walnut.

#### 17. Req. #2018-032: 118 North Primrose Ave (blue ADA curb) – Parking

Resident requesting a blue ADA curb in front of their residence due to a neighbor shared driveway, detached shared duplex garage at the rear of the property, and being an under-parked property.

#### 1. <u>Req. #2018-033: 500 block of Wild Rose Ave (south side at Wild Rose Elementary)</u> – <u>Parking</u>

Wild Rose Elementary School is requesting the removal of the NO PARKING restrictions (9:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. and 1 p.m. - 3:30 p.m.) on the 500 block of Wild Rose, on the north side of the school. The buses no longer park at this location and now park on Heliotrope.

2. Req. #2018-034: Foothill Blvd and Alta Vista Ave (crosswalk) – Traffic / Safety

Resident requesting the re-installation of the removed raised pavement markers identifying the crosswalk at the Foothill and Alta Vista intersection crossing Foothill.

- 3. <u>Req. #2018-035: Canyon Blvd and Lime Ave (crosswalk) Traffic / Safety</u> Resident requesting a crosswalk at the intersection of Canyon and Lime.
- Req. #2018-036: 100 300 blocks of East Cherry Ave (signage) Traffic / Safety Resident requesting the installation of 25 mph signage on the 100 – 300 blocks of E Cherry.
- 5. <u>Req. #2018-037: 610 East Walnut Ave (red curbing) Traffic / Safety / Parking</u> Resident requesting red curbing at the driveway apron for line-of-site safety.
- 6. <u>Req. #2018-038: Canyon Blvd and Maple Ave (street sweeping signage at Canyon</u> <u>Early Learning Center) – Parking</u>

Resident requesting that the street sweeping time be changed from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. as parents need street parking for school drop-off and pick-up between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.

- <u>Req. #2018-039: 100 block of East Palm Ave (Post Office) Parking</u> Parking Enforcement requesting, on behalf of residents, to have the 24 minute parking (except for Sundays) changed to include Sundays, as there is no parking available to
- Req. #2018-040: 1953 Peck Rd (red curbing) Traffic / Safety

Resident is requesting red curbing at the driveway apron for line-of-site safety and to reduce the 35 mph speed limit to 25 mph due to excessive speeding. *Cross-referenced with Reg. #2017-050.* 

- <u>Req. #2018-041: 303 South Madison Ave (red curbing) Traffic / Safety</u> Resident requesting red curbing at the driveway apron for line-of-site safety and to enforce the 25 mph speed limit on the street due to excessive speeding.
- 10. <u>Req. #2018-042: Sierra Terrace between Sesmas St and Royal Oaks Dr (speed cushions) Speeding</u>

Resident requesting a speed study and traffic calming on Sierra Terrace between Sesmas and Royal Oaks.

Resident requesting a speed study and traffic calming on Colorado between Canyon and Shamrock.
