TITLE: Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for November 2018

OBJECTIVE: To provide an update on incidents, maintenance, and public comments related to Canyon Park and the Hillside Wilderness Preserve (HWP) recorded for the month of November 2018.

BACKGROUND: For over a century, Canyon Park has been used as a recreational park by visitors and Monrovia residents. Services in Canyon Park include special events; Naturalist led night hikes, interpretive tours, a Nature Center, trails, a waterfall, and views of the San Gabriel Valley. In addition, Naturalists, with the support of many volunteers that maintain the trail system and facilities.

In 2016, the City opened over 4.5 miles of HWP trials providing passive recreational opportunities for the community. Park Naturalists patrol the HWP as well as urban parks two times a day by vehicle, utility terrain vehicle, and foot. Park Naturalists also respond to calls related to Monrovia's No Smoking Ordinance.

The included HWP and Canyon Park Log provide additional information related to the Comments, Maintenance, Incidents, and Events which occurred in November 2018.

ANALYSIS: During the month of November 2018, Park Naturalists completed 132 hours of maintenance throughout the Hillside Wilderness Preserve and 140 hours in Canyon Park. The maintenance included invasive species removal, brush clearance and diverting water to prevent erosion with edge barriers and water bars. Programs for November included Kids Craft in the Canyon that was held on Sunday, November 25. This month's craft was making native plant holiday wreaths. Park Naturalists led third, fourth, and fifth grade education tours for Monroe, and Holy Angels elementary schools.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Community Services Commission move to receive and file CC-2, Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for November 2018.
