TITLE: Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for April 2019

OBJECTIVE: To provide an update on incidents, maintenance, events and public comments related to Canyon Park and the Hillside Wilderness Preserve (HWP) recorded for the month of April 2019.

BACKGROUND: For over a century, Canyon Park has been used as a recreational park by visitors and Monrovia residents. Services in Canyon Park include special events, Educational Tours, Naturalist led Night Hikes, Interpretive Tours, a Nature Center, trails, a waterfall, and views of the San Gabriel Valley. In addition, Naturalists, with the support of many volunteers, maintain the trail system and facilities.

In 2016, the City perfected over 4.5 miles of HWP trials providing passive recreational opportunities for the community. Park Naturalists patrol the HWP as well as Urban Parks two times a day by vehicle, utility terrain vehicle, and foot. Park Naturalists also respond to calls related to Monrovia's No Smoking in Parks Ordinance.

The included HWP and Canyon Park Log provide additional information related to the Comments, Maintenance, Incidents, and Events which occurred in April 2019.

ANALYSIS: During the month of April 2019, Park Naturalist and Volunteers worked on maintaining Canyon Park and HWP's hiking trails. Park Naturalists and Volunteers completed 104 hours of maintenance throughout the Hillside Wilderness Preserve and 118 hours in Canyon Park. The maintenance included brush clearance, trail maintenance, and invasive species removal.

On Saturday, April 6, the Monrovia Police Department cited vehicles that were parked in a "No Parking Zone" on Ridgeside. On Sunday, April 7, Officers responded to a burglary alarm call from Station 103; the call was a false alarm.

Earth Day was celebrated on Saturday, April 20 at Canyon Park's Nature Center from 1:00-3:00 p.m. Patrons participated in Arts and Crafts, Face Painting, and Volunteers led a hike to the Waterfall; during the hike, participants, Volunteers and Naturalists picked up trash in celebration of Earth Day. California Native Plant Society was also in attendance to promote native and drought tolerant plant gardening. On Sunday, April 28, Canyon Park continued to celebrate Earth Day by turning water bottles into succulent planters during the Kid's Craft in the Canyon Event.

Programs included Park Naturalists led Kindergarten and Frist Grade Education Tours for Plymouth, Wildrose, Mayflower, Bradoaks, and Monroe Elementary schools. On Thursday, April 4, Park Naturalists led a Trout in the Classroom program for Mark Twain Elementary School.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Community Services Commission move to receive and file CC-2, Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for April 2019.
