TITLE: Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for June 2019

OBJECTIVE: To provide an update on incidents, maintenance, and public comments related to Canyon Park and the Hillside Wilderness Preserve (HWP) recorded for the month of June 2019.

BACKGROUND: For over a century, Canyon Park has been used as a recreational park by visitors and Monrovia residents. Services in Canyon Park include Special Events; Naturalist led Night Hikes, Interpretive Tours, a Nature Center, trails, a waterfall, and views of the San Gabriel Valley. In addition, Naturalists, with the support of many volunteers, maintain the trail system and facilities.

In 2016, the City opened over 4.5 miles of HWP trials providing passive recreational opportunities for the community. Park Naturalists patrol the HWP as well as urban parks two times a day by vehicle, utility terrain vehicle, and foot. Park Naturalists also respond to calls related to Monrovia's No Smoking Ordinance.

The included HWP and Canyon Park Log provide additional information related to the Comments, Maintenance, Incidents, and Events which occurred in June 2019.

ANALYSIS: During the month of June 2019, Park Naturalist and Volunteers worked on maintaining Canyon Park and HWP's hiking trails. Park Naturalists and Volunteers completed 108 hours of maintenance throughout the Hillside Wilderness Preserve and 105 hours in Canyon Park. The maintenance included brush clearance, erosion control, and invasive species removal.

On Saturday, June 29 and Sunday, June 30, Park Naturalist and Volunteers hosted the first 2019 Family Hike and Campout. Participants enjoyed day and night hikes, family craft activities, library storytime, s'mores, and out camping related activities.

Programs for Canyon Park included Park Naturalist led Education Tours on Monday, June 3 for Hillcrest Elementary; Thursday, June 13 for Monrovia Adult School English Learners; Friday, June 14 for California Retired Teachers Association; and Wednesday, June 19 for Canyon Park Naturalist led an Interpretive Tour for Kaplin International Adult Learners Group. On Saturday, June 30, Park Naturalists hosted the Kids Craft in the Canyon; participants built and decorated Butterfly Feeders for their gardens.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Community Services Commission move to receive and file CC-2, Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for June 2019.
