**731 East Huntington Drive – Applicant, - ALDI, Incorporated**

**Request:** Allow the sale of beer and wine for off-site consumption (Type 20 ABC License) at a new food market in an existing commercial shopping center in the CRS (Commercial Regional/Subregional) zone. Determine that the project is Categorically Exempt (Class 1) from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

For public hearings and appeals, the applicant is invited to speak first, followed by those who support the project, then those who have concerns or oppose the project. The applicant is then given the opportunity to rebut. Appellants will be afforded the same opportunities as applicants.

**AGENDA ITEMS:** The Agenda contains the regular order of business of the Planning Commission. Items on the Agenda have generally been reviewed and investigated by the City Staff in advance of the meeting so that the Planning Commission can be fully informed about a matter before making its decision.
