TITLE: Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for August 2019

OBJECTIVE: To provide an update on incidents, maintenance, and public comments related to Canyon Park and the Hillside Wilderness Preserve (HWP) recorded for the month of August 2019.

BACKGROUND: For over a century, Canyon Park has been used as a recreational park by visitors and Monrovia residents. Services in Canyon Park include special events, staff led hikes, interpretive tours, a Nature Center, access to trails, a waterfall, and views of the San Gabriel Valley. In addition, the staff and volunteers maintain the trail system and facilities.

In 2016, the City opened over 4.5 miles of HWP trails providing passive recreational opportunities for the community. Park Naturalists patrol the HWP as well as urban parks two times a day by vehicle, utility terrain vehicle, and foot. Park Naturalists also respond to calls related to Monrovia's Smoking Ban Ordinance in parks.

The included HWP and Canyon Park Log provide additional information related to the Comments, Maintenance, Incidents, and Events for August 2019.

ANALYSIS: During the month of August 2019, Park Naturalist and Volunteers worked on maintaining Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserves' hiking trails. Park Naturalists and Volunteers completed 112 hours of maintenance throughout the Hillside Wilderness Preserve and 114 hours in Canyon Park. The maintenance included brush clearance, erosion control, facility grounds maintenance, and invasive species removal.

Park Naturalist assisted the Monrovia Fire Department, Monrovia Police Department, and Los Angeles County Search and Rescue on Monday, August 12 with a lost hiker who went off trail near the Canyon Park Waterfall. The hiker was located and brought to safety by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's helicopter team.

Park Naturalist and Volunteers hosted a Family Hike and Campout Event on Saturday, August 24 to Sunday, August 25. Participants enjoyed day and night hikes, family craft activities, library story time, s'mores, and other camping related activities. Kids Craft in the Canyon was hosted on Sunday, August 25 at the Nature Center. Participants had an opportunity to learn about wildlife food sources and create healthy snacks for their hike to the waterfall.

On Sunday, August 26, Park Naturalists assisted Monrovia Fire, Monrovia Police, Los Angeles County Search and Rescue, and Park Naturalist assisted Los Angeles County Sheriffs with a search for a missing person. After an extensive search, Los Angeles County Sheriffs determined that Canyon Park was clear and the search concluded.

On Monday, August 26, a portion of the Cloverleaf hiking trail was temporarily closed because of a large tree that fell onto the trail. On Saturday, August 30, West Coast Arborist removed the tree and the trail was reopened to the public.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Community Services Commission move to receive and file CC-2, Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for August 2019.
