TITLE: 2019 Fall Program Update

OBJECTIVE: To provide the Community Services Commission with information related to the upcoming City-Sponsored Fall Programs and Events

DISCUSSION: Each season the Community Services Department hosts a variety of special events and programs for the community. Old Town Fall Festival Saturday, October 12 12:00 – 4:00 p.m.

The 2nd Annual Old Town Fall Festival is scheduled for Saturday, October 12 from 12:00 – 4:00 p.m. The intent of the program is to encourage visitors to explore the businesses in Old Town Monrovia that they might not yet discovered. By encouraging shoppers and diners to participate in a scavenger hunt, or pause as their child completes a craft, they may see something new and find a new favorite haunt! Our goal is to get people into the businesses while having a terrific family friendly experience.

The Costume Contest will be held in Library Park and is free of charge with registration beginning at 2:00 p.m. The Halloween Bash is a rain or shine event. In the event of rain, the costume contest will be held in the Community Center.
