**TITLE:** Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for December 2019

**OBJECTIVE:** To provide an update on incidents, maintenance, and public comments related to Canyon Park and the Hillside Wilderness Preserve (HWP) recorded for the month of December 2019.

**BACKGROUND:** For over a century, Canyon Park has been used as a recreational park by visitors and Monrovia residents. Services in Canyon Park include special events; Naturalist led night hikes, interpretive tours, a Nature Center, trails, a waterfall, and views of the San Gabriel Valley. In addition, Naturalists and volunteers maintain the trail systems and facilities.

In 2016, the City opened over 4.5 miles of HWP trails providing passive recreational opportunities for the community. Park Naturalists patrol the HWP and urban parks two times a day by vehicle, utility terrain vehicle and foot. Park Naturalists also respond to calls related to Monrovia's Smoking Ban Ordinance.

The included HWP and Canyon Park Log provide additional information related to the comments, maintenance, incidents, and events which occurred in December 2019.

**ANALYSIS:** During the month of December 2019, Park Naturalist and Volunteers worked on maintaining Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserves' hiking trails. Park Naturalists and Volunteers completed 104 hours of maintenance throughout the Hillside Wilderness Preserve and 112 hours in Canyon Park. The maintenance included erosion control, tree removal, debris and slide clearing, and reinforcing the hiking trails.

On December 26 the Canyon Park's Waterfall Trail was closed due to a tree that fell on the trail causing an obstruction on the trail. The following day Park Naturalists and Volunteers removed and cleared the tree and reopened the trail for public use.

Programs during the month of November include Park Naturalists and Volunteers leading education tours for 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade classes for Monroe and Mayflower Elementary.

On December 5, Park Naturalists assisted in the Holiday Parade with traffic and crowd control on Myrtle Ave. and Primerose Ave. The Canyon Park Volunteers participated with a entry in the Holiday Parade.

On Friday, December 20, Park Naturalists responded to a patron who reported small fire in the Fireman's Flat Campground. The Park Naturalists located the small fire, extinguished the flames, and called Monrovia Fire and Police for additional assistance. Monrovia Firefighters extinguished the remainder of the burning coals. Monrovia Police Officers located the suspect who started the fire and arrested the individual.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends the Community Services Commission move to receive and file CC-2, Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for December 2019.
