TITLE: Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for January 2020

OBJECTIVE: To provide an update on incidents, maintenance, and public comments related to Canyon Park and the Hillside Wilderness Preserve (HWP) recorded for the month of January 2020.

BACKGROUND: For over a century, Canyon Park has been used as a recreational park by visitors and Monrovia residents. Services in Canyon Park include special events; Naturalist led night hikes, interpretive tours, a Nature Center, trails, a waterfall, and views of the San Gabriel Valley. In addition, Naturalists and volunteers maintain the trail systems and facilities.

In 2016, the City opened over 4.5 miles of HWP trials providing passive recreational opportunities for the community. Park Naturalists patrol the HWP and urban parks two times a day by vehicle, utility terrain vehicle and foot. Park Naturalists also respond to calls related to Monrovia's Smoking Ban Ordinance.

The included HWP and Canyon Park Log provide additional information related to the comments, maintenance, incidents, and events which occurred in January 2020.

ANALYSIS: During the month of January 2020, Park Naturalist and Volunteers worked on maintaining Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserves' hiking trails. Park Naturalists and Volunteers completed 109 hours of maintenance throughout the Hillside Wilderness Preserve and 115 hours in Canyon Park. The maintenance included brush clearace, invasive species removal, erosion control, tree removal, debris and slide clearing, and reinforcing the hiking trails.

Programs during the month of January include Park Naturalists and Volunteers leading education tours for 1st, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade classes for Mayflower, Wildrose, and Monroe Elementary.

During the month of January, Park Naturalists responded to two incidents in Canyon Park. On January 10, Park Naturalists repsoneded to a patron hiking on the trail complaining about breathing with elevated and irregular heart arithmia. Monrovia Fire assisted the patron with medical care and transported her to Arcaida Methodist Hospital for further evaluation. On Wednesday, January 29, Park Naturalist called Monrovia Fire and Police to assist with a subject that was intoxicated with alcohol in Canyon Park. Monrovia Police Officers located the suspect and Monrovia Fire Paramedics transported the her to Arcadia Methodist Hospital for further medical attention.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Community Services Commission move to receive and file CC-3, Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for January 2020.
