TITLE: Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for February 2020

**OBJECTIVE:** To provide an update on incidents, maintenance, and public comments related to Canyon Park and the Hillside Wilderness Preserve (HWP) recorded for the month of February 2020.

**BACKGROUND:** For over a century, Canyon Park has been used as a recreational park by visitors and Monrovia residents. Services in Canyon Park include special events; Naturalist led night hikes, interpretive tours, a Nature Center, trails, a waterfall, and views of the San Gabriel Valley. In addition, Naturalists and volunteers maintain the trail systems and facilities.

In 2016, the City opened over 4.5 miles of HWP trials providing passive recreational opportunities for the community. Park Naturalists patrol the HWP and urban parks two times a day by vehicle, utility terrain vehicle and foot. Park Naturalists also respond to calls related to Monrovia's Smoking Ban Ordinance.

The included HWP and Canyon Park Log provide additional information related to the comments, maintenance, incidents, and events which occurred in February 2020.

**ANALYSIS:** During the month of February 2020, Park Naturalist and Volunteers worked on maintaining Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserves' hiking trails. Park Naturalists and Volunteers completed 102 hours of maintenance throughout the Hillside Wilderness Preserve and 118 hours in Canyon Park. The maintenance included brush clearace, invasive species removal, erosion control, and reinforcing the hiking trails. On February 17th Park Naturalist assisted the Monrovia High School Mountain Bike team members with a "Trail Work Give Back Day" to improve and maintain a portion of a hiking trail near Station 103.

Programs during the month of February include Park Naturalists and Volunteers leading MUSD education tours for 1<sup>st</sup> grade classes for Monroe, Mayflower, Plymouth Elementary. Park Naturalists and Volunteers also led an education tour for outside districts 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students from Pearl Prep Elementary School.

On February 19<sup>-</sup> Park Naturalist provided public safety while Southern California Edsion replaced an power pole within HWP.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends the Community Services Commission move to receive and file CC-2, Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for February 2020.
