

Voting by Mail

- No postage necessary
- Ballot Return Checklist
 - Place voted ballot card(s) inside Official Return Envelope
 - Securely seal the Official Return Envelope
 - **SIGN AND DATE** the back of the Official Return Envelope
- Postmarked by Election Day
 - Processed, verified, and counted if received within 17 days
- Signature Verification / Signature Missing
 - Up to 28 days after Election Day to return Signature Verification Statement or Unsigned Ballot Statement
- May also be dropped off at Vote Center
 - By voter or an authorized person

Ballot Drop Box

Located at Monrovia Public Library on Palm Avenue

- Across from Community Center
- October 5 through November 3 at 8 p.m.
- Securely collected every 72 hours, then every 24 hours

• Security:

- Securely bolted into cement
- Designed with all required security features
- Library location in view of security cameras

Ballot Return Checklist

- Place voted ballot card(s) inside Official Return Envelope
- Securely seal the Official Return Envelope
- **SIGN AND DATE** the back of the Official Return Envelope
