TITLE: Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for August 2020

OBJECTIVE: To provide an update on incidents, maintenance, and public comments related to Canyon Park and the Hillside Wilderness Preserve (HWP) recorded for the month of August 2020.

BACKGROUND: For over a century, Canyon Park has been used as a recreational park by visitors and Monrovia residents. Services in Canyon Park include special events; Naturalist led night hikes, interpretive tours, a Nature Center, trails, a waterfall, and views of the San Gabriel Valley. In addition, Naturalists and volunteers maintain the trail systems and facilities.

In 2016, the City opened over 4.5 miles of HWP trials providing passive recreational opportunities for the community. Park Naturalists patrol the HWP and urban parks two times a day by vehicle, utility terrain vehicle and foot. Park Naturalists also respond to calls related to Monrovia's Smoking Ban Ordinance.

Since mid-March 2020, in response to the potential exposure of COVID-19 and under the guidance received by local, state and federal officials, the decision was made to close the Community Center, Library, HWP and Canyon Park to the public.

In May 2020, HWP and portions of Canyon Park reopened to the public. To ensure propoer social distancing in Canyon Park, additional steps were implemented to restrict access. A new reservation system was developed to help ensure a limited number of visitors, both residents and nonresidents, have the opportunity to enjoy Canyon Park while also managing large crowds. Reservations are limited to 70 per timeslot, with three timeslots available every weekday. All visitors looking to enter the park must have a reservation, whether driving, biking or walking into Canyon Park. A \$5.00 parking fee is required for visitors to park inside Canyon Park.

Trail modifications were established to ensure safe, physical distancing such as:

- One-Way Trail Loops
- Portions of the Waterfall Trail and Ben Overturf Trail closed
- Limited Trail Use Hours
 - o Monday Friday: 6:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
 - Closed Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays

ANALYSIS: During the month of August 2020, Park Naturalist worked on maintaining Canyon Park and HWP hiking trails. Canyon Park Volunteers completed 118 hours of miantenace on various hiking trails and roadways in Canyon Park. Park Naturalist completed 15 hours of maintenace on HWP hiking trails. The maintenance included reinforcing hiking trails, brush clearace, tree removal, and erosion control.

On August 14-19 Canyon Park and HWP were closed to the public due to high tempretures, poor air quality from neighboring fires, and high fire danger.

On August 19 Bellfree Contractors began work on the two locations in HWP where previous rains washed out the trail causing concerns for public safety. The project finished on August 24 with minimal trail closures to the public, resulting in a safer trail for patrons to hike and mountain bike.

Below you will find the details related to the trail reservation system during the month of August. Staff is monitoring trail use through the reservations system and have revieved postitive feedback on how organized and safe patrons feel when hiking Canyon Park.

Since the launch of the program, Staff continue to meet with the Trail Task Force to provide and use up to date information that is consistant with LA County health officers guidelines realted to COVID-19.
