HISTORY OF MONROVIA ELECTION DATES

- 1942 1972 April
- 1974 1978 March
- 1980 1994 April
- 1997 2005 March
- 2009 2017 April
 - SB 415 (statewide primary or statewide general; date changed in 2018)
- 2020 present March
 - SB 970 (primaries in March in years divisible by 4 or June in other even years)
- 2022 June?

COMPLICATIONS AS A RESULT OF STATE LAW CHANGES

- Aligning regular local elections with statewide primary or statewide general elections means (for now) a variable election date depending on the year.
- The 2022 regular municipal elections must be held on the primary election date.
- The result is likely that, in the future, some terms will expire in March and some terms will expire in June.
- Ballot capacity concerns with adding new local elections in November.

SB 590 - ALLEN

- Any term of office set to expire in March or April 2022 <u>shall</u> be extended to expire following the certification of election results following the June 7, 2022 statewide primary election and the administration of the oath of office to the new officeholder.
- Recommend that the City Council support SB 590 and direct staff to prepare documents to align the 2022 regular municipal election with the June primary.
