THE IDEA

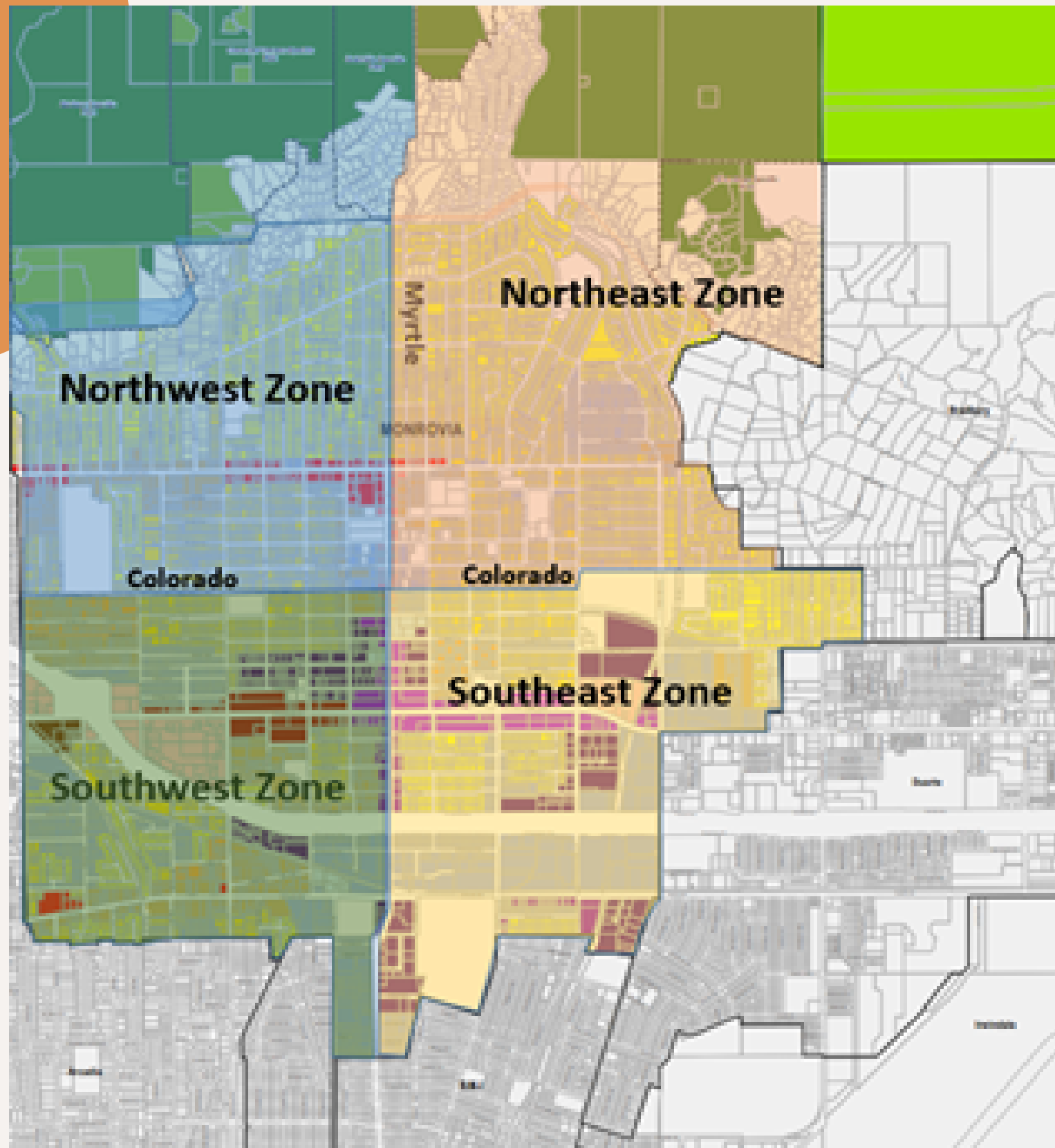
- AFTER GRADUATING FROM THE LEADERSHIP ACADEMY, NEW MAP LEADERS CAN VOLUNTEER TO JOIN THEIR LOCAL NETWORK IN A ZONE.
- ALL THAT IS NEEDED IS YOUR NAME, EMAIL, AND WHAT ZONE YOU ARE IN.
- 4 ZONES – NORTHWEST, NORTHEAST, SOUTHWEST, AND SOUTHEAST.
- GOAL: ENHANCE NETWORKING BETWEEN NEIGHBORS TO STAY INFORMED AND IMPROVE THEIR NEIGHBORHOOD.



MAP LEADER ZONES

MYRTLE AVE. IS THE CENTER LINE

- NORTHWEST ZONE (BLUE) – NORTH OF COLORADO AND WEST OF MYRTLE
- NORTHEAST ZONE (ORANGE) – NORTH OF COLORADO AND EAST OF MYRTLE
- SOUTHWEST ZONE (GREEN) – SOUTH OF COLORADO AND WEST OF MYRTLE
- SOUTHEAST ZONE (YELLOW) – SOUTH OF COLORADO AND EAST OF MYRTLE



ZONE LEADERS & CO-LEADERS

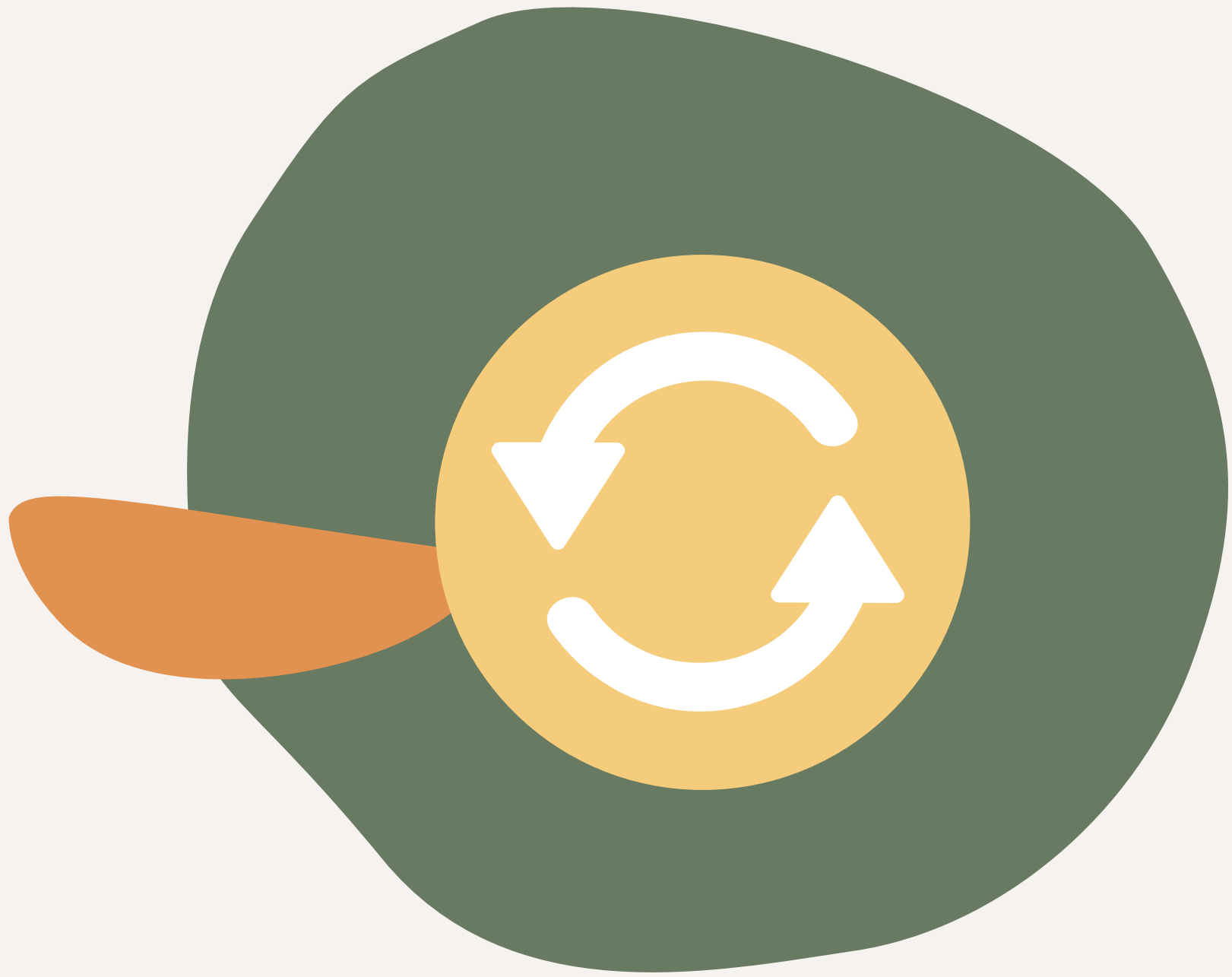

SIGNAGE

YARD SALES

- PERMITS AVAILABLE THROUGH CODE ENFORCEMENT FOR \$5.00
- ONCE PER EVERY 6 MONTHS
- NO SIGNS ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

REAL ESTATE SIGNS

- CANNOT BE ON PUBLIC PROPERTY.
- IF PICKED UP BY CODE ENFORCEMENT, SIGNS CAN BE RETRIEVED AT CITY HALL MONDAY-FRIDAY



TRASH CAN STORAGE

- TRASH CANS MAY GO OUT IN FRONT OF YOUR PROPERTY STARTING AT SUNSET THE DAY BEFORE COLLECTION.
- TRASH CANS MUST BE REMOVED FROM VIEW BY SUNSET ON THE DAY OF COLLECTION.
- HELP INFORM NEW RESIDENTS OF PROPER STORAGE.
- TRASH CANS MUST BE STORED OUT OF PUBLIC VIEW DURING THE REST OF THE WEEK.






BULKY ITEMS

- RESIDENTS CAN SCHEDULE BULKY ITEM PICK-UPS THROUGH ATHENS.
- 2 FREE PICK-UPS PER YEAR.
- CODE ENFORCEMENT PROACTIVELY REPORTS ITEMS THROUGHOUT THE CITY.
- HELP INFORM NEIGHBORS OF THE NEED TO CALL ATHENS FOR BULKY ITEMS.

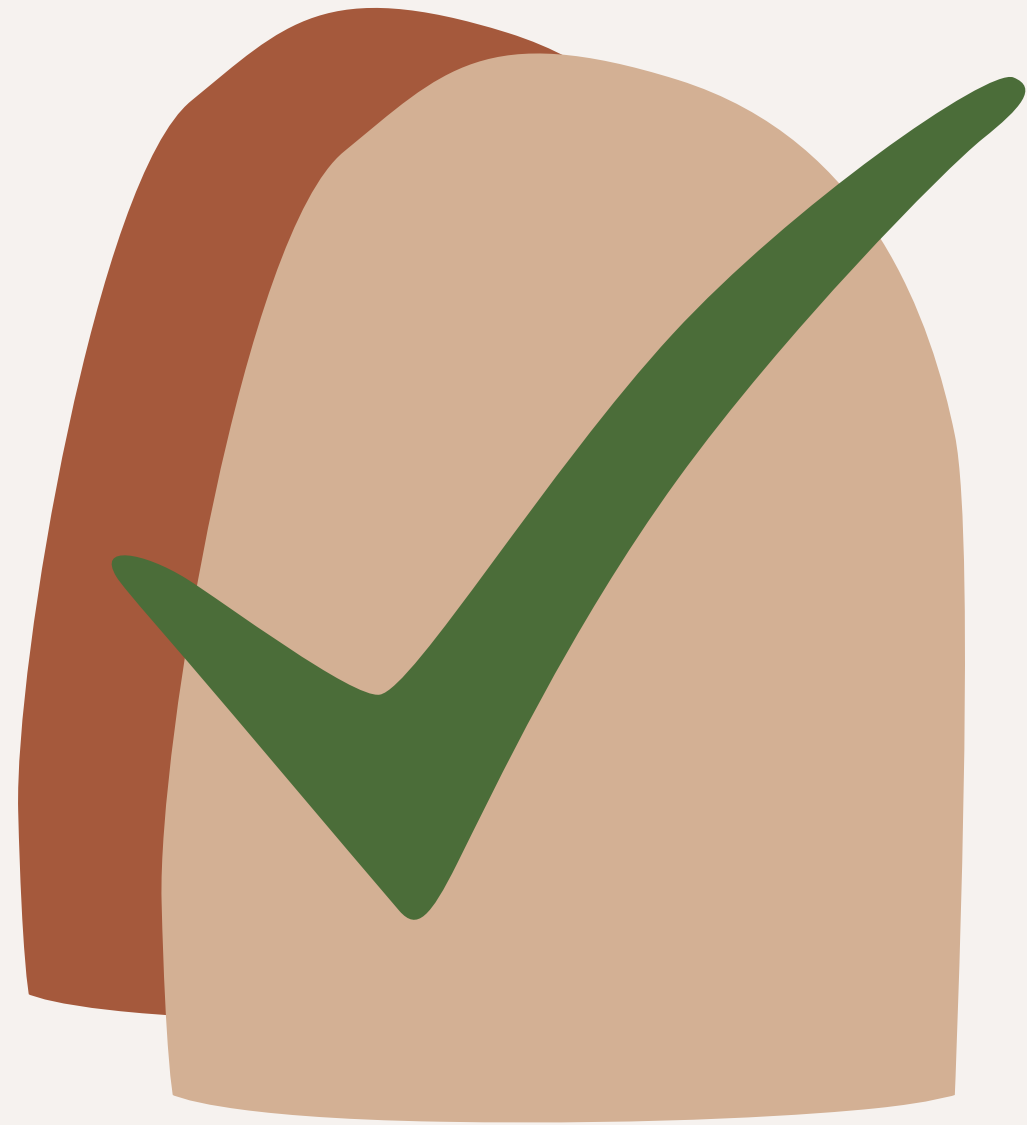
Our Mission

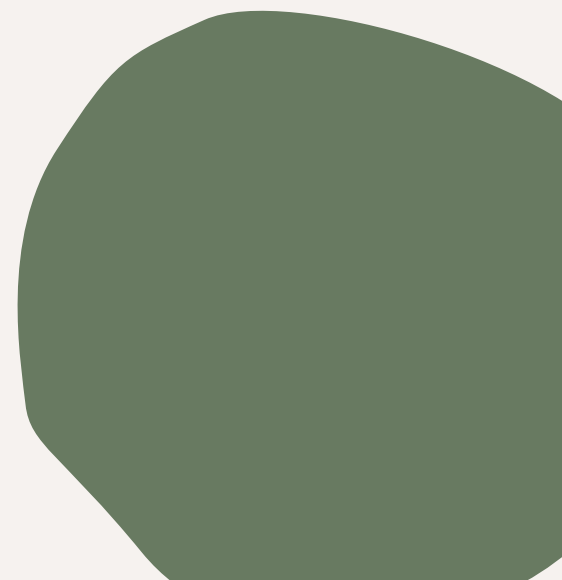

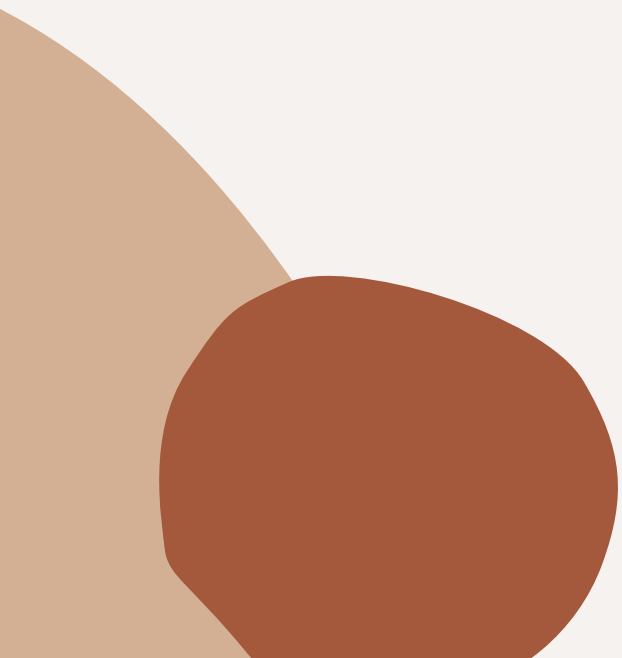
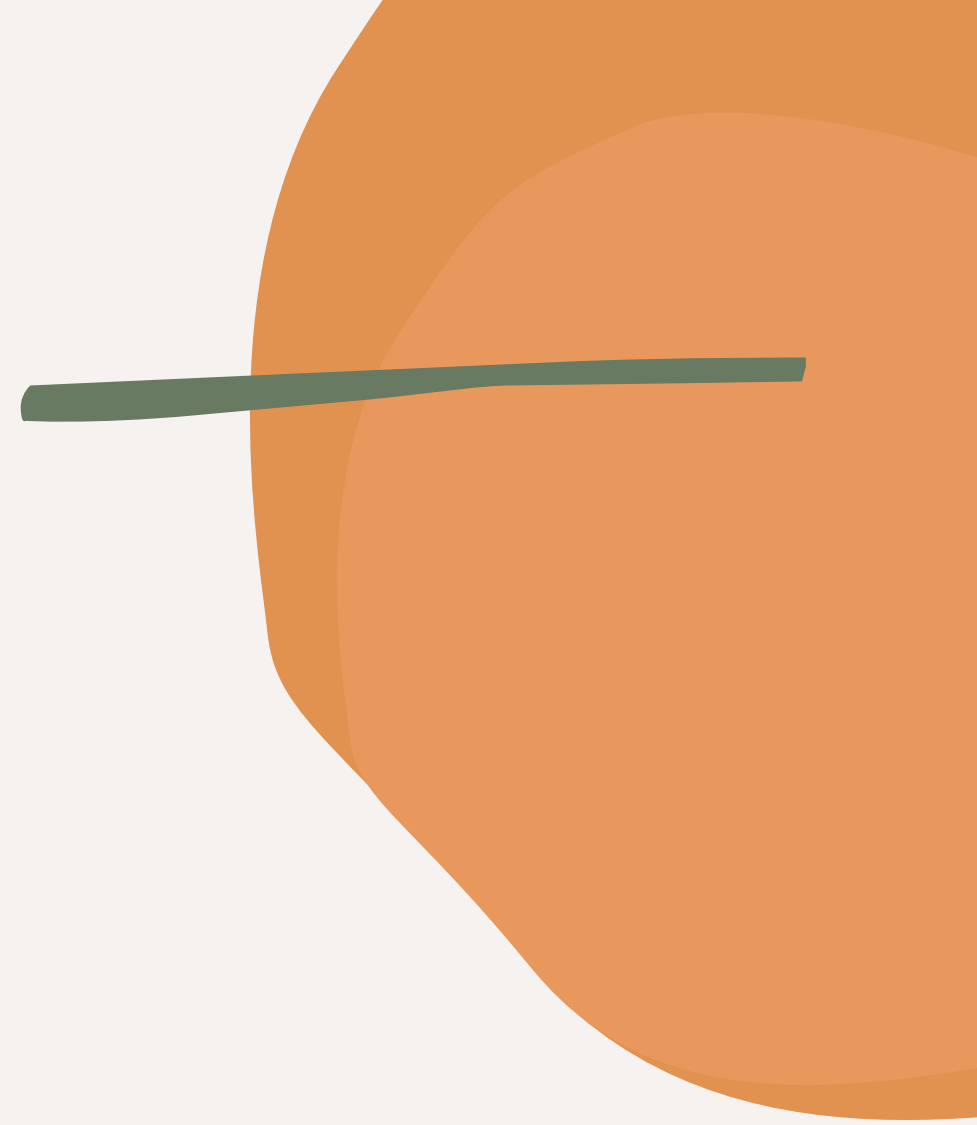
