


MAP LEADER ZONES A NEW STRATEGY AT UNITING MAP LEADERS!

- WILL HELP PROVIDE FEEDBACK TO THE MAP TEAM.





YARD SALES

- **ENFORCEMENT FOR \$5.00**
- ONCE PER EVERY 6 MONTHS

REAL ESTATE SIGNS • CANNOT BE ON PUBLIC PROPERTY. • IF PICKED UP BY CODE ENFORCEMENT, SIGNS CAN BE RETRIEVED AT CITY HALL MONDAY-FRIDAY

• PERMITS AVAILABLE THROUGH CODE NO SIGNS ON PUBLIC PROPERTY



TRASH CAN STORAGE


- TRASH CANS MAY GO OUT IN FRONT OF YOUR PROPERTY STARTING AT SUNSET THE DAY BEFORE COLLECTION.
- TRASH CANS MUST BE REMOVED FROM VIEW BY SUNSET ON THE DAY OF COLLECTION.
- HELP INFORM NEW RESIDENTS OF PROPER STORAGE.
- TRASH CANS MUST BE STORED OUT OF PUBLIC VIEW DURING THE REST OF THE WEEK.





BULKY ITENS

• RESIDENTS CAN SCHEDULE **BULKY ITEM PICK-UPS** THROUGH ATHENS. • 2 FREE PICK-UPS PER YEAR. CODE ENFORCEMENT **PROACTIVELY REPORTS ITEMS** THROUGHOUT THE CITY. HELP INFORM NEIGHBORS OF THE NEED TO CALL ATHENS FOR BULKY ITEMS.



Our Mission







TYPE OF EVENT

Choose your focus of the event - youth engagement, neighborhood engagement, community engagement, neighborhood meeting, volunteering, block party, "just because", the list can go on & on but it is up to YOU or the group you are planning the event with!

VENUE

Figuring out the focus/theme of the event will help you choose the best venue for your event. It may be a park, someone's home, an entire street

DELEGATE TASKS

Delegate tasks to have a successful and stress-free event. Get a signup sheet & pass it around for individuals to sign up for something they would be interested in helping with i.e. food, advertising, games, etc. and that way it isn't a burden on 1 person. #TeamworkToMakeTheDreamWork

RESERVE ALL THE NECESSITIES

The venue, food, speakers, but most importantly reserve your ATTENDEES by sending out invitations - digital or printed. Tip: If you're on a budget, the most cost-effective way to advertise succesffuly is doing it digitally.




