Request: Advisory Review for a conditional use permit application for a church to located in the HCD (Historic Commercial-Downtown) Zone.

Determine that the project is Categorically Exempt (Class 1) pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

Decision: Pre-application review completed. Determination that a professional traffic study conducted by a traffic engineer and verification of the 5 year fire sprinkler inspection is required for the formal Conditional Use Permit application.
