## **Local Home Research**

Resources include:

- The "About My House" page on the Community Development website has an index to permits from 1911–1947 and a link to a searchable database for newer permits (1948 to present). If you are unsure the year your home was built, call Community Development at 626–932–5565.
- **City Directories** the library has directories (with some gaps) from 1908–1971. There are also some available online by visiting <u>cityofmonrovia.pastperfectonline.com</u> (Tip: search "business directory" or "telephone")
- Online Historical Indexes these compile names, addresses, and other subjects across several local history books and files. The indexes can be found on the library's "Local History" page by visiting monrovialibrary.org
