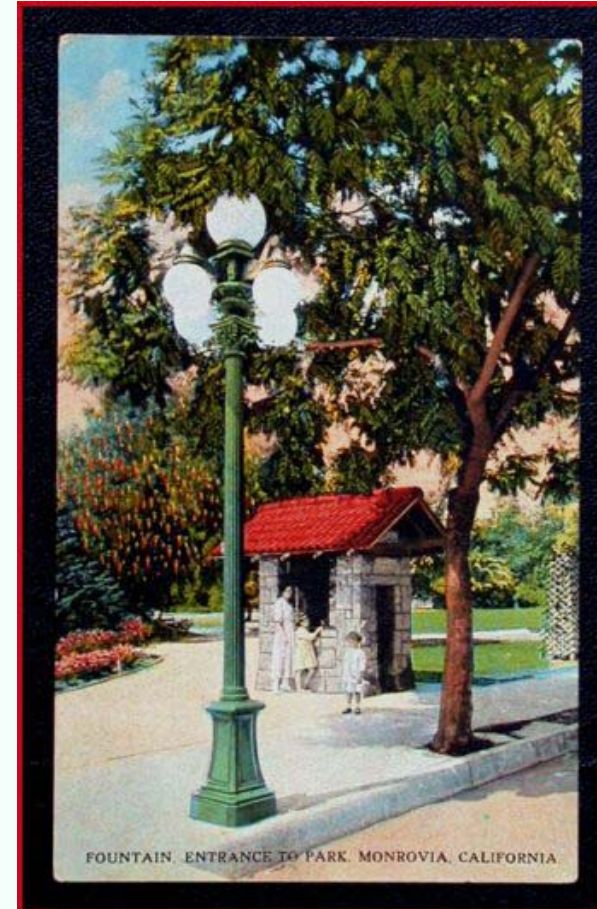

# Monrovia Duarte Farmers' Club

- Farmers' Club was founded in the early 1900's
- Many meetings focused on raising of poultry
- Constructed and dedicated the fountain to the City in 1909
- Disbanded in November 1909



# Farmers Club Fountain

- Small cut granite canopy structure
- Open gable roof with clay pantiles
- Exposed, decorative rafter tails
- Center granite portion between columns removed at some point

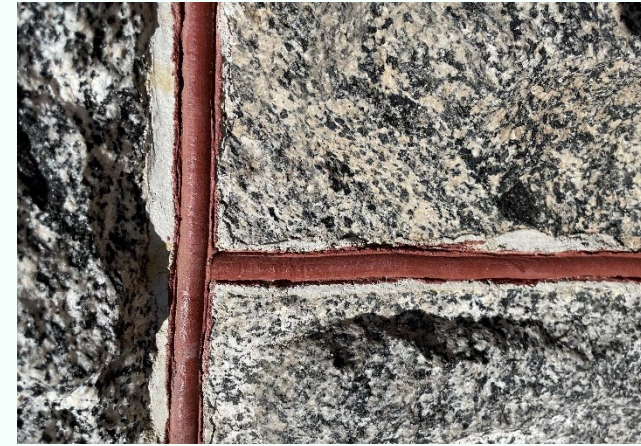




# Damage and Restoration

- Significantly damaged by an automobile in 2013
- Restored due to the joint efforts of MOHPG and the City
- Granite was reset in its original placement and repointed
- Roof rebuilt using salvaged and refabricated materials.
- About half the tiles had to be replaced.





# Designation Criteria

- **Criteria 5** – It has a unique location or physical characteristics or represents an established and familiar feature of neighborhood, community or the city.
- **Criteria 6** – It incorporates elements that help preserve and protect a historic place or area of historic interest in the city.
