


MEASURE K Roadshow Keep Monrovia Revenues Local **Sales Tax Measure**



Measure K

On November 5, 2019, residents of Monrovia voted to approve Measure K, the Keep Monrovia Revenues Local Sales Tax Measure. Measure K collects the remaining 0.75% sales tax allowed under state law and ensures new sales tax revenues stay in Monrovia and are reinvested into our community.





West San Gabriel Valley Mental Evaluation Team

- Established in 2016
- Collaboration between LA County DMH and (Monrovia PD, Arcadia PD, Irwindale PD and South Pasadena PD)
- MET unit consist of one law enforcement officer and one mental health clinician
- Monrovia PD MET consist of one community policing officer and one mental health clinician
- MET unit responds to assist officers in their contacts with mentally ill citizens

MET Services

Assists field personnel by conducting field evaluations

Responds to calls involving persons with mental health disorders to defuse potentially volatile situations

Provides crisis intervention, referrals and follow-up of persons with mental health disorders who do not meet the criteria of 5150 W.I.C.

Provides support and resources to families who have a loved one with mental illness





Handles the detainment, transportation and the admittance of the individual into a mental health facility when appropriate

MET can be a resource to patrol units

- MET services are type dispatch
- Information provided to dispatch
- Monrovia MET has responded to calls of:
 - Attempted suicides
 - Mental Health crisis requiring an emergency response
 - Crisis involving r ill individuals
 - Families facing other types of disturbances involving mental illness
 - Other minor crimes involving mentally ill individuals where there will be no prosecution

MET services are typically requested through 911

Crisis involving mentally ill or violently mentally






