



Map of City with School Routes

- Approximately 60 intersections that are designated as the "Safe Route to School"
- Route is designated by the yellow paint



Traffic Safety Committee

- The Traffic Safety Committee (TSC) is comprised of the Public Works, Community Development and Police Departments.
- The TSC meets monthly or as needed to discuss requests, activities or recommendations from the public
- The TSC developed a Neighborhood Traffic Calming Policy to help mitigate traffic issues in residential neighborhoods
- Examples of traffic calming are:
 - Center line or edge line striping
 - New Stop Sign analysis and installation
 - O Enhanced Signage
 - Traffic Control and enforcement upon request

Recent Safety Improvements

O Safe Routes to School Project

- Raised crosswalk, new signage, striping and concrete improvements by Bradoaks Elementary
- O New signage and striping improvements by Santa Fe School
- O Longer loading zone for pick-up and drop-off at Wildrose Elementary
- Traffic Improvements on Olive Ave by Monroe Elementary School

Safe Routes to School Project

The City received over \$400,000 in Caltrans grant funding for this Safe Routes to School Project

The City has spent over 6 years of staff time managing this grant.



LED Stop Sign

High powered/Solar powered signs than are visible up to 1 mile away

Easily attached to existing sign posts

Encapsulating wiring to protect against the elements




Potential Wildrose Improvements

Pedestrian crosswalk signs (in-street)



Total Cost	\$600,000	\$60,000	\$900,000
