

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
MONROVIA MEASURE K CITIZEN  
ADVISORY COMMITTEE  
HELD THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 2021, AT 11:00 A.M.**

**CONVENE:** Chair Janet Wall convened the Regular Meeting of the Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee on Thursday, September 16, 2021, at 11:03 a.m. Staff in attendance: City Manager Dylan Feik, Assistant City Manager Lauren Vasquez, Administrative Services Director Buffy Bullis, Deputy Administrative Services Director Rae Bowman, Deputy Public Works Director Alex Tachiki, Senior Management Analyst Emy-Rose Hanna, and Senior Management Analyst Angela Cho. In accordance with Executive Order N-29-20, the meeting was conducted via video conference.

**CONSENT CALENDAR:**

**CC-1 Unadopted Minutes of the September 16, 2021, Regular Meeting**

It was moved by Vice Chair Brenda Trainor to accept the Minutes of the April 22, 2021, Regular Meeting, and seconded by Committee Member Philip Tiffany. The motion carried unanimously.

After further discussion, the Committee requested Staff to include the *Providers Group* and *Monrovia Reads* to the list of outreach groups. The Committee also gave additional recommendations for outreach and asked to be kept informed of the outreach efforts being made by the City.
