Public comment will not be read aloud; however, the full text will be provided to all members of the Commission prior to the meeting and a summary will be provided during the meeting. If comments are specifically in support or opposition of an item, please clearly state so in the introduction.

MATTERS NOT ON THE AGENDA should be presented during the time designated as "PUBLIC INPUT." Speakers will be heard on a first come, first served basis. By State law, the Traffic Safety Committee may not discuss or vote on items not on the agenda.

MATTERS ON THE AGENDA: If you wish to address the Traffic Safety Committee on a matter on the agenda, please wait until the Chair opens the public hearing or calls for public comment on that matter. For public hearings and appeals, the Applicant is invited to speak first, followed by those who support the project, then those who have concerns or oppose the project. The Applicant is then given the opportunity to rebut. Appellants will be afford the same opportunities as applicants.
