

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
MONROVIA TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE
HELD THURSDAY, MAY 19, 2022**

In accordance with Government code Section 54953(e), and guidance from the California Department of Public Health on gatherings, the Traffic Safety Committee made the determination that there would be no physical meeting location. CONVENE: Chair Tachiki convened the Regular Meeting of the Traffic Safety Committee on Thursday, May 19, 2022, at 4:08 p.m.

NEW AGENDA ITEMS:

1. Req. #2022-019 - 1626 S. Mayflower Avenue. Resident requests installation of red curb and loading zone.

Recommendation: Approve the installation of red curb along Mayflower Avenue on the south side of the driveway and installation of a Loading Zone along the North end of Mayflower Avenue.
