AT A GLANCE

Placement

The program does not initiate the replacement of sidewalk panels, however takes advantage of opportunities when new sidewalks are installed.

The Community Development Department staff coordinates with developers, contractors and builders on stamp delivery and placement.

Stamping

Stamping concrete takes skill and instructions must be followed to ensure proper placement and appearance. Public Works is responsible for the installation if the City is installing the sidewalk, otherwise the property owner's contractor will do the installation.

WHAT IS FOOTNOTES?

The City of Monrovia values public art; recognizing the cultural, social, and economic benefits it provides public spaces. "Footnotes" is one of Monrovia's ongoing Signature Art programs. This program is designed with the goal of highlighting "word as art" and is comprised of sidewalk poetry (short writings submitted by residents) and "Monrovia Moments" (fun historical tidbits) stamped into newly poured sidewalks throughout the City.

INFORMATION ON SIDEWALK STAMPING FOR CONTRACTORS

- 1. Text should be perpendicular to the street, orient the stamp to the proper direction.
- 2. Center the stamp on the sidewalk and between square marks
- 3. Use stamp release on the stamp (available at Home Depot)
- 4. Press evenly through out the stamp
- 5. Pick up stamp evenly
