

RESOLUTION NO. 98-77

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROVIA, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT TO THE OFFICES OF THIS CITY THAT WERE TO BE ELECTED ON TUESDAY, MARCH 2, 1999

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROVIA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California, as of the close of the nomination period on December 4, 1998, there were not more candidates than offices to be elected and that § 10229 of the elections Code allows one of the following courses of action to be taken by the City Council

- 1 Appoint to the office the person who has been nominated
- 2 Appoint to the office any eligible voter if no one has been nominated
- 3 Hold the election if either no one or only one person has been nominated

WHEREAS, a notice was published on December 9, 1998 in a newspaper of general circulation pursuant to law

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROVIA, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to § 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the following action is being taken

The following persons are being appointed to the offices to which they were nominated

- 1 Robert T Bartlett, Mayor
- 2 Thomas E Adams, Councilmember
- 3 Lara L Blakely, Councilmember

SECTION 2. The election scheduled to be held on Tuesday, March 2, 1999 is now cancelled


SECTION 3. The persons appointed, if any, shall qualify and take office and serve exactly as if elected at a municipal election for the office





NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to Section 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California relating to the General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, March 2, 1999. As the close of nomination period on December 4, 1998, there are not more candidates than offices to be elected.
That Section 10229 of the Elections Code allows one of the following courses of action to be taken by the City Council:
1. Appoint to the office the person who has been nominated.
2. Appoint to the office any eligible voter if no one has been nominated.
3. Hold the election if either no one or only one person has been nominated.
The City Council will meet on Tuesday, December 15, 1998 at 6 PM to either make the appointment(s) or direct an election to be held. The person(s) appointed, if any, shall qualify and take office and serve exactly as if elected for a municipal election for the office.
If by the 75th day before the municipal election, no person has been appointed to the office(s) pursuant to (1) or (2) above, the election shall be held.
If the City Council makes an appointment pursuant to Section 10229, Elections Code, the City Clerk shall not accept for filing any statement of write-in candidacy which is submitted after the appointment is made.

AVISO QUE INSUFICIENTES CANDIDATOS SE HAN REGISTRADO PARA EL PUESTO POR MEDIO DE LA PRESENTE SE DA AVISO que de acuerdo con la Sección 10229 del Código de Elecciones del Estado de California tocante a la Elección General la cual será conducida el martes, Marzo 2, 1999.
Al cierre del periodo de postulación el Diciembre 4, 1998, insuficientes candidatos han sido nominados para cada puesto en la ciudad.
La Sección 10229 del Código de Elecciones permite uno de los siguientes cursos de acción para ser tomado por el Concejo Municipal:
1. Nombrar al puesto a la persona quien ha sido nominada.
2. Nombrar al puesto a cualquier votante eligible si nadie ha sido nominado.
3. Conducir una elección si nadie o solo una persona ha sido nominada.
El Concejo Municipal se reunirá el Martes, Diciembre 15, 1998 a las seis (6 PM) para hacer el (los) nombramiento(s) o dirigir que una elección sea conducida. La(s) persona(s) nombrada(s), si alguna lo es, calificara y tomara el puesto y servirá exactamente como si hubiese sido elegido al puesto durante una elección municipal.
Si en el septuagésimo quinto (75) día anterior a la elección municipal, ninguna persona ha sido nombrada al puesto de acuerdo con el (1) o el (2) de más arriba, la elección será conducida.
Si el Concejo Municipal hace un nombramiento de acuerdo con la Sección 10229, Código de Elecciones, la (el) secretaria(o) municipal no aceptara para registro ninguna declaración de candidatura insertada la cual es presentada después que un nombramiento se ha hecho.
