Traffic Impact Fee Ordinance (2019-05)

- Based on the Mitigation Fee Act, the City of Monrovia adopted a Traffic Impact Fee (TIF) in 2019 that affects new development south of Huntington Drive.
- TIF funds will be used to implement improvements to maintain an acceptable flow of traffic (level of service). These improvements include:
 - Signal coordination/synchronization
 - Existing signal equipment upgrades
 - New signal installation
 - Physical right-of-way modifications



Traffic Impact Fee Adjustment

- The Traffic Impact Fee Ordinance provides for regular adjustments to the fee based on changes to the California Construction Cost Index (CCCI).
- Adjustments to an Impact Fee require a public hearing.
- Recommended fee increase from \$2,153 to \$2,353 per new PM peak hour trip.
- Implemented through the adoption of Resolution No. 2023-01



Traffic Impact Fee Annual Report

- As required by Mitigation Fee Act and the Traffic Impact Fee
 Ordinance, an annual report must be prepared. The report must
 contain the following information:
 - Purpose of the Fee
 - Amount of the Fee
 - Fund Balance
 - Public Improvements Funded
 - Intra-fund transfers or loans
 - Refunds and allocations from the Fund



Traffic Impact Fee Annual Report

For the FY ending June 30, 2022, the TIF Fund had the following activity:

The negative amount of "other revenue" is due to a fiscal year end adjustment to record cash and investments at fair market value per Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) Statement No. 31.
