- Constructed and dedicated the "bandstand" in 1927 as its first civic project.






Bandshell Structure

- Designed by Robert Finlayson
- Constructed by V.R. Bush
- Hipped roof structure with mission tiles
- Exposed, embellished rafter tails
- Roof supported by two pairs of square posts atop of stucco pilasters with a decorative piece at the top.
- Coved ceiling/interior wall
