# Rotary Club of Monrovia

- Initiated the application for landmark designation
- Celebrating 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary
- Chartered in 1922
- Constructed and dedicated the “bandstand” in 1927 as its first civic project.



# Bandshell Structure

- Designed by Robert Finlayson
- Constructed by V.R. Bush
- Hipped roof structure with mission tiles
- Exposed, embellished rafter tails
- Roof supported by two pairs of square posts atop of stucco pilasters with a decorative piece at the top.
- Coved ceiling/interior wall

# Designation Criteria

- **Criteria 5** – It has a unique location or physical characteristics or represents an established and familiar feature of neighborhood, community or the city.
