

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
MONROVIA TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE
HELD THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2022**

CONVENE: Chair Alex Tachiki convened the Regular Meeting of the Traffic Safety Committee on Thursday, November 17, 2022, at 4:03 p.m. in the Public Works Training Room, 600 South Mountain Avenue, Monrovia, California.

ROLL CALL: In attendance were Chair Alex Tachiki, Committee members Richard Gibson and Lori Bashford, and Secretary Sheri Bermejo. Vice Chair Kevin McCune was excused.

REPORTS FROM PREVIOUS AGENDA ITEMS:

1. **Req. #2022-031 – Oakdale Avenue between S. Shamrock Avenue and S. Mountain Avenue. Residents request to review street sweeping hours on Oakdale Avenue.**

Recommendations: 1) Direct staff to issue a petition to shorten street sweeping hours on Oakdale Avenue; and 2) Table a motion to adjust street sweeping hours along Lime Avenue and Wildrose Avenue.

It was moved by Secretary Bermejo, seconded by Committee member Gibson to approve the request to issue a petition to shorten street sweeping hours on Oakdale Avenue and table a motion to adjust street sweeping hours along Lime Avenue and Wildrose Avenue. The motion carried with a 4-0 vote.

2. **Req. #2022-044 – N. Primrose Avenue from W. Foothill Boulevard to W. Hillcrest Boulevard. Prospect Avenue. Resident requests traffic calming.**

Recommendation: Approve targeted enforcement and installation of centerline striping.
