TITLE: Measure K Financial Update and Budget Calendar

**BACKGROUND:** During the Measure K meeting on October 10, 2022, the Monrovia Measure K Citizen Advisory Committee (the Committee) was provided with a financial update based on *pre-audit* estimates for Fiscal Year 2021-22, since the City had not yet completed its financial audit at that time. Now that the City has closed the books for Fiscal Year 2021-22 and the financial audit is complete, updated Measure K revenues, expenditures, and fund balances are being provided for Fiscal Year 2021-22 as part of this financial update. Additionally, a high-level overview of Measure K interest earnings will be provided, as well as a review of the City's budget calendar and key Measure K dates.

**ANALYSIS:** Below is a summary of Measure K revenues, expenditures, and estimated fund balances through the end of Fiscal Year 2022-2023. It is estimated that the Measure K Fund Balance will be approximately \$16,465,158 at the end of Fiscal Year 2022-23, as noted in the table below.

#### **Revenues:**

#### Measure K Sales Tax Revenues:

Overall, Measure K revenues remain strong and continue to show growth each year. For Fiscal Year 2021-22, total actual revenues (including interest revenue) of \$6,384,327 were approximately 4% higher than the prior year. At this time, the estimate for Fiscal Year 2022-23 budgeted revenues is \$6,462,000, which is \$13,000 higher than the original projection. Staff is currently preparing a Fiscal

Year 2022-23 quarterly budget review (for Quarter 3) that will be presented to City Council in May, and Measure K budgeted revenues will be requested to be adjusted from \$6,449,000 to \$6,462,000 as part of the quarterly review.

#### Interest Earnings:

All City funds, including Measure K funds, earn interest annually. City funds are pooled and invested to maximize interest earnings. Funds are invested in compliance with the guidelines of the City's Investment Policy, for which the main objectives are:

- 1. Preservation of capital and protection of investment principal;
- 2. Maintenance of sufficient liquidity to meet anticipated cash flows;
- 3. Attainment of a market value rate of return; and
- 4. Diversification to avoid incurring unreasonable market risks.

When accounting for cash, as mentioned above, the City uses a "pooled cash" concept for its funds. Interest earnings are allocated to each fund based on a pro-rata share of that fund's monthly cash balance in relation to the balance of all cash in all City funds. As such, interest earnings have been recorded in the Measure K Fund based on this allocation method each year. Interest earnings, like sales tax revenues, roll into fund balance if not used during the year. Below is a summary of year-end cash balances and interest earnings in the Measure K Fund by fiscal year:

<sup>\*\$290,630</sup> was received in June 2020. Therefore, interest revenue only includes one month of interest earnings.

Investment earnings are dependent on market conditions. In recent years, the City's investments have been earning approximately .5% - 1.5% annually. However, recently, during Fiscal Year 2022-23, the City has seen an increase in investment yields, due to market conditions. Therefore, for Fiscal Year 2022-23, an increase in overall interest earnings is expected.

#### **Expenditures:**

As the Committee will recall, for Fiscal Year 2021-22, five projects were approved for Measure K funding by the City Council. Now that the audit is complete for Fiscal Year 2021-22, updated actual expenditures are provided below, as follows:

As the Committee will recall, any unused funds (i.e., actual expenditures are less than budget) will roll into reserves.

#### **Fiscal Year 2022-23:**

During the Measure K meeting in October 2022, an update was provided to the Committee regarding the status of budgeted expenditures for Fiscal Year 2022-23. As the Committee will recall, for Fiscal Year 2022-23, four projects were originally approved for Measure K funding by the City Council; however, during the Fiscal Year 2022-23 Budget process in June 2022, an alternative funding source was identified in the City's operating budget for the Annual Server Replacement Project for \$15,000 and the Storage Area Network Unit – City Hall Project for \$75,000, so these items were removed from Measure K. Below are the final expenditures approved by City Council for Measure K use during Fiscal Year 2022-23:

- 1. Transfer to Workers Compensation Fund \$500,000
- 2. Transfer to General Fund Reserves \$500,000

At this time, no new Measure K expenditures have been approved by the City Council. As discussed at the last Measure K meeting, the direction from City Council remains the same. Due to the unforeseen damage caused by debris flow within Monrovia Canyon Park in December 2021 and January 2022, and with the additional damage caused by the most recent rainstorms in December 2022 and January 2023, City Council has decided to hold off on appropriating any Measure K funding at this time. It is anticipated that the City Council will be discussing budget and finances in the upcoming months as part of the budget process.

#### **Budget Calendar:**

The preparation of the Fiscal Year 2023-25 Two-Year Citywide Budget is currently underway. To that end, attached to this report is a copy of the budget calendar, which includes dates for budget preparation, upcoming budget study sessions, and formal budget approval. Additionally, as outlined in the Measure K Financial Policy, City Council will review a Measure K Spending Plan two times a year. The Plan will then be presented to the Committee for review and comment. Below is a schedule for approval of the Spending Plan and subsequent presentation to the Committee:
