It was moved by Secretary Bermejo, seconded by Committee member Bashford to approve the installation of centerline striping and updated signage along Magnolia Avenue; the Committee also delegates authority to Public Works Director/Chair Tachiki and City Traffic Engineer/Committee member Gibson to analyze and compare the stop warrant analysis for the intersection of S. Magnolia Avenue and Lemon Avenue and the intersection of S. Magnolia Avenue and Lime Avenue in order to decide which is the appropriate intersection for a four-way stop; Staff shall also review the Pedestrian Safety Plan to determine what other improvements are necessary to ensure pedestrian safety at both intersections.
