TITLE: Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for July 2023.

OBJECTIVE: To provide an update on incidents, maintenance, and public comments related to Canyon Park and the Hillside Wilderness Preserve (HWP) recorded for the month of July 2023.

BACKGROUND: For over a century, Canyon Park has been used as a recreational park by visitors and Monrovia residents. Services in Canyon Park include special events; Naturalist led night hikes, interpretive tours, a Nature Center, trails, a waterfall, and views of the San Gabriel Valley. In addition, Naturalists and volunteers maintain the trail systems and facilities. Park Naturalists also respond to calls related to Monrovia's Smoking Ban Ordinance.

In 2016, the City opened over 4.5 miles of HWP trails providing passive recreational opportunities for the community. Park Naturalists patrol the HWP and urban parks two times a day by vehicle, utility terrain vehicle and foot. In September 2020, the Bobcat Fire forced the closure of Canyon Park and HWP for an extended period of time, as the areas were unsafe and significant repairs were needed. Since then, limited hiking opportunities in San Gabriel Valley has increased amount of daily visitors to HWP, primarily in Ridgeside and Cloverleaf access points.

Staff has been intimately involved with cleanup and rehabilitation towards Canyon Park roads, trails and infrastructure. Over the next several months Staff will continue to assess and identify damages from rainstorms, identify infrastructure repairs, and oversee the possibilities of upgrades to Canyon Park.

The construction plans for Canyon Park which are close to 100% complete. The project estimate is between \$17-\$18 million. Some of the general scope of work will include, replacing roadway in segments of the park, changing the cross-slope of the roadway to prevent future debris from flowing directly down the center of the park, replacing all parking lots and adding approximately 24 new parking spaces, replacing the water main, installing a booster pump to feed water from the Oakglade tank, and removing the old Canyon Park water tank, installing a 6" sewer line and removing septic tanks, repairing damaged culverts, guardrails, walls, etc. and one of the exciting components of the park project is the addition of approximately 10 new features or enhancements to the park.

ANALYSIS: During the month of July 2023, Canyon Park Volunteers completed 118 hours of maintenance in Canyon Park. Maintenance performance included debris removal from the trail, tree clearing, and reestablishing a trail.

During the month of July, Management Career Solutions (MCS) assisted with post fire and rainstorm disaster recovery in Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve (HWP). Recovery efforts include

debris removal that fell on the trail, and invasive species removal and clearing. Staff is continuing to monitor their progress of work as they assist in Canyon Park and HWP's post fire and rainstorm rehabilitation.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Community Services Commission move to receive and file CC-2, Canyon Park and Hillside Wilderness Preserve Patrol Update for July 2023.
