## What

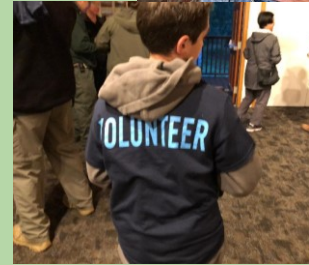
To renovate the Canyon Park ranger station to make the floors, walls, ceiling, lighting and furniture better to enhance the experience for both the rangers and the public.

- Love the people who work there

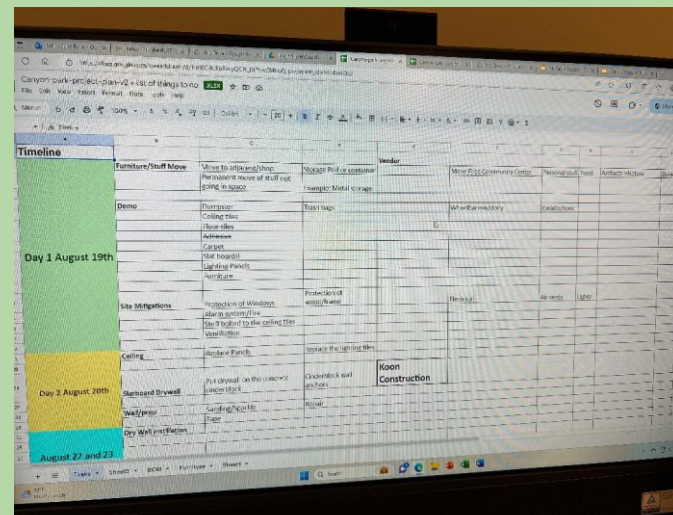
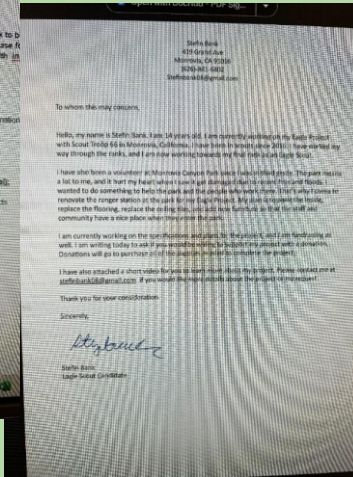
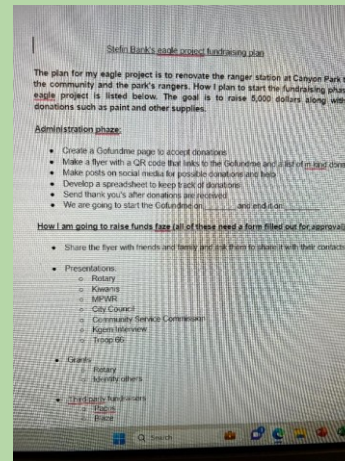

- Moved inside due to rain



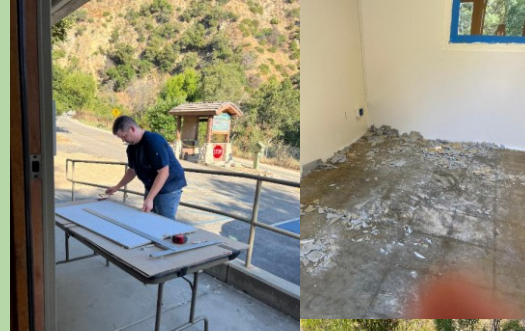


# Professional flooring and drywall during the week as well as replacing ceiling tiles

- Special thanks to City Manager Dylan Fiek, Eugene Zuk and Matthew McCarthy for their volunteer support in putting up the ceiling tiles.

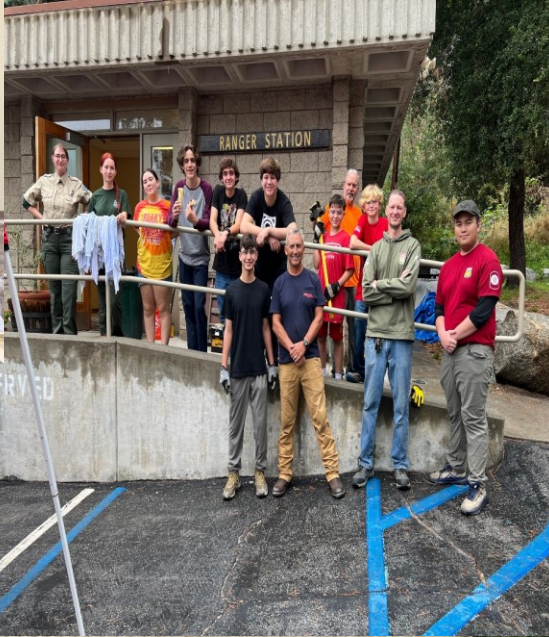

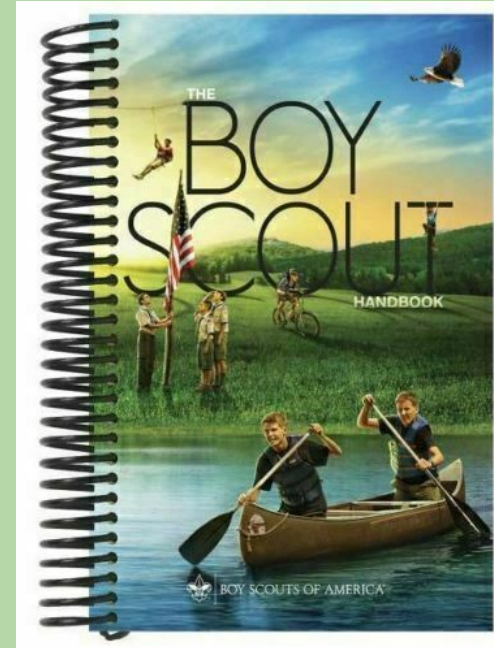
