### Why is Athens Looking Inside My Containers?

As part of Senate Bill (SB) 1383 compliance requirements, customers may find Athens' "Lid Flippers" surveying their neighborhood. These custom right-hand-drive Jeeps are tasked with assessing a customer's recycling, organics, and trash containers for contamination.

Drivers manually open each container to inspect the contents. If contamination is found (such as trash in the organics container), the auditor photographs, reports, and places a "Customer Notification Tag" on the container to notify the customer of the issue and any required action.

### ORGANICS: WHAT GOES WHERE?

Not sure what to do with your organics waste? Athens has you covered. Here is a list of items that can and cannot be placed in your green organics container.

#### ACCEPTABLE ORGANICS WASTE

#### **GREEN WASTE**

- · Flower & hedge trimmings
- Grass clippings
- Leaves & branches
- Lumber, scrap wood, & plywood (not painted or treated)
- Weeds

#### FOOD SCRAPS

- · Bread, rice, & pasta
- · Cheese & dairy
- · Coffee grounds & filters
- · Fruits & vegetables
- · Flowers & herbs
- · Meat, bones, & poultry
- · Seafood & soft shells
- Pet food (non-medicated)

#### FOOD-SOILED PAPER\*

- · Food-stained paper
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper napkins & kitchen towels
- Pizza boxes
- Plates
- To-go boxes (no coating)
- Wooden & fiber-based utensils

\*Must be 100% fiber-based. No materials with petroleum-based plastic, wax, or bio-plastic coating, liner or laminate

## O DO NOT INCLUDE

- All plastics
- Cacti, succulents, & yucca
- Compostable plastics (bioplastics)
- Coffee cups & pods
- Fats, oils, & grease
- Food stickers (please remove)
- Hard shells (clams, mussels, oysters)
- Medication

- · Palm fronds
- Paper napkins & towels with cleaning chemicals
- Parchment & wax paper
- Pet waste
- Rocks & soil
- Rubber bands & twist ties
- Tea bags
- Textiles
- · Tissues & wet wipes
