Historical Background

Characteristics of <u>Multi-Family Development:</u> 1903-1940


- Modest duplexes
- Designed to blend in with single family homes in the neighborhood
- Unified exterior design, similar to a single family home
- Represents popular architecture
- Similar in scale and setbacks to single family homes
- Low density (few units per lot)
- Semi-private courtyard space




Characteristics of Multi-Family Development, 1903-1940. Duplex at 134 Grand Avenue constructed in 1920

Mills Act Contract Work Plan

- Seismic retrofit
- Electrical safety inspection
- Landmark plaque
- Improved public visibility
 - More transparent public views to courtyard
 - Smaller native plants within the front yard planter
