**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** It was moved by Vice Chair Hull, seconded by Committee member Gibson to approve the minutes of the September 21, 2023, Regular Meeting. The motion carried with a 5-0 vote.

**NEW AGENDA ITEMS:**

1. **Req. #2023-0043 – Southwest corner of Duarte Road and Encino Avenue. Resident requests a red curb.**

Recommendation: Approve installation of a red curb.

It was moved by Secretary Bermejo, seconded by Committee member Gibson to approve the installation of a red curb at the southwest corner of Duarte Road and Encino Avenue. The motion carried with a 5-0 vote.

2. **Req. #2023-0044 – Foothill Boulevard, Greystone Avenue, and Hillcrest Boulevard between Fifth Avenue and Mountain Avenue. Resident requests Bear Crossing warning signage.**

**3. Req. #2023-0045 – 715-721 W. Duarte Road. Resident requests a red curb.**

Recommendation: Approve installation of a red curb.

It was moved by Vice Chair Hull, seconded by Committee member Bashford to approve the installation of 52 feet of pre-existing red curb and an additional 39 feet of red curb adjacent to the driveway of 715-721 W. Duarte Road. The motion carried with a 5-0 vote.
