TITLE: 2016 Monrovia Day Parade Street Closure Request

BACKGROUND: The Monrovia Day Parade has been traditionally planned by the Monrovia Day Association, in cooperation with the City of Monrovia, and is offered on the Saturday closest to the City's incorporation date of May 17. The parade and related festivities are designed to celebrate the City's birthday.

ANALYSIS: This year's Parade is scheduled for Saturday, May 14 from 9:00 – 10:15 a.m. and will be offered in partnership with the Monrovia Unified School District. The parade route begins at Myrtle and Walnut Avenues, traveling north on Myrtle Avenue and concludes at Palm Avenue. Staff is requesting street closures in Old Town from 7:00-11:00 a.m. in the following areas:

- Myrtle Avenue from Huntington Drive to Foothill Boulevard
- Maple Avenue from Ivy to Primrose Avenues
- Chestnut Avenue from Ivy to Primrose Avenues
- Walnut Avenue from Ivy to Primrose Avenues
- Olive Avenue from Ivy to Primrose Avenues
- Colorado Boulevard from Ivy to Primrose Avenues
- Lemon Avenue from Ivy to Primrose Avenues
- Lime Avenue from Ivy to Primrose Avenues
- Palm Avenue from Ivy to Primrose Avenues

Foothill Boulevard and Huntington Drive will remain open for through traffic. MOTAB has approved all previous Monrovia Day Parade street closure requests.

OPTIONS: Staff has provided the following options for consideration:

1. Recommend approval of the 2016 Monrovia Day Parade Street Closure Request.
2. Do not recommend approval of the street closures and/or request more information from Staff.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Board approve option No. 1, approval of 2016 Monrovia Day Parade Street Closure Request.

MOTION: If the Board concurs, the appropriate action is a motion to approve the 2016 Monrovia Day Parade Street Closure Request.
