Responsibilities

- Supervises all Old Town Filming & serves as a liaison between individual merchants and the Film Company.
- Follows established Old Town Film Guidelines, and determines (with City Staff) if a filming permit in Old Town is approved.
- Assesses the Filming Impact fee paid by the Film Company
- Ensures that the film company is following the approved permit.
- Mitigates all unauthorized amendments to the film permit.
- Communicates with the Film LA Site monitors to ensure the film permit is being followed.
- Responds to and reports any filming concerns and/or emergencies to City Staff.

- Monitors all impacted locations during filming to ensure that permit guidelines are followed.
- Immediately reports any permit changes/infractions to the Film Company and Film Liaison.
