- Originally part the National Old Trails Road
- U.S. Highway 66 was established in 1926
- Original route traveled north on Shamrock
 Ave and continued west along Foothill Blvd
- Realigned in 1933 along Huntington Drive
- In 2026, Route 66 will celebrate its centennial






Selection Process

- Request for Qualifications released in February
- AIPP Committee selected three finalists from 11 submissions
- Finalists received a \$1000 stipend to develop design
- AIPP Committee recommending the design by Monrovia-based artist Ryan Burch


