

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Monrovia Planning Commission October 11, 2023, 7:30 PM

CONVENE: Chair Vachani convened the Regular Meeting of the Monrovia Planning Commission on Wednesday, October 11, 2023, at 7:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 415 South Ivy Avenue, Monrovia, California. PUBLIC HEARINGS:

PH-1 Conditional Use Permit; CUP2023-0009 428 South Myrtle Avenue, Joey Kouchakian, Applicant

Assistant Planner Austin Arnold presented the staff report and answered questions of the Planning Commission regarding whether there was a concern for over-saturation of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) licenses in Old Town given the number of restaurants that are currently approved to serve beer and wine.

Public Input: Joey Kouchakian, applicant, spoke in favor of the application and provided an overview of the restaurant's business operation, as well as the provisions and requirements of the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) license.
