GoMonrovia Overview

- Monrovia has provided transportation services since 1983 (Monrovia Transit)
- GoMonrovia approved in 2018
 - Introduced "GoMonrovia" Lyft Pass
 - Monrovia Transit reserved for individuals with disabilities
- GoMonrovia won the 2020 ICMA Program Excellence Award
- Monrovia Transit expansion launched July 1, 2023
 - DOJ-required and grant-funded
- Both programs operate 24/7/365
- Objective:
 - 1) To modify GoMonrovia service hours and Lyft Pass structure, making transportation services financially sustainable; and
 - 2) Approve an agreement with Pro Park, LLC (Pro Park) for the provision of dispatch and ADA transit services.




GoMonrovia

(currently operating 24/7/365)




\$3.00 GoMonrovia Lyft Pass Monrovia Transit (seniors 62+ and individuals with disabilities)

Analysis Recap

- Three presentations one study session (9/17) and both October council meetings
- Reviewed FY 23-24 estimated actual costs, FY 24-25 forecasted estimates based on FY23-24 ridership and ridership data.
- Continuing "business as usual" is not fiscally sustainable over time
- Staff proposed reducing service hours and revising the \$3 Lyft Pass subsidy
- Key goals/concerns:
 - Continued partnership with Lyft, offering Monrovians discounted rides
 - Late-night service on weekends
 - Balance with Monrovia Transit operations
 - Long-term financial sustainability

Proposed Changes

1. Modified Service Hours

- Sun Thurs 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Fri Sat 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.
- Continued service on holidays

2. Modified Lyft Pass Fare Structure


Shift to a City-issued \$3.00 discount per trip


GoMonrovia Lyft Pass – Current Conditions

- \$3.00 Lyft rides (private, up to four people) within Monrovia and to approved medical locations
- Up to 121 discounted trips per rider per month
- Rider pays \$3.00; City covers the rest
- City's cost varies based on Lyft's pricing model
- Code: GOMONROVIA

Rider pays \$3.00 City pays remaining, variable cost (\$5.54 average in FY 23-24)

Total Cost Per Trip





GoMonrovia Lyft Pass – Proposed Conditions

- City issued \$3.00 discount per Lyft ride (private, up to four people) within Monrovia and to approved medical locations
- Up to 121 discounted trips per rider per month
- City pays \$3.00; Rider covers the rest
- City's cost varies based on ridership only
- Code: GOMON

City pays \$3.00 base cost


Rider pays remaining, variable cost (\$5.54 average in FY 23-24)

Example: GoMonrovia Lyft Pass


Proposed Conditions

Standard Lyft Trip = \$8.61 City Discount = - \$3.00 Rider Cost = \$5.61



Launch Date and Outreach Plan

- Revised program launches January 1, 2025
- All Lyft Pass holders must input the "GOMON" Lyft Pass
- Lyft pass and transit tutorials available on website
- Outreach will include updates to Monrovia Transit code of conduct and best practices for using Monrovia Transit on Lyft

Summary

- New service hours
 - o Sun Thurs 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
 - Fri Sun 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.
- New Lyft Pass
 - Instead of \$3.00, flat-rate trips within Monrovia and to approved locations,
 GoMonrovia Lyft Pass holders will receive a \$3.00 discount per trip
- Program revisions will help ensure long-term financial sustainability
- Staff will return with an update on actual ridership and expenditure data in Summer 2025 and/or at Council's discretion
- Recommended Action:
 - Approve the proposed revisions to GoMonrovia and Agreement with Pro Park for the provision of ADA-compliant transportation and dispatch services
