- C. FOLLOW-UP ITEMS
- Req: #2015-177: Permit Parking on Hidden Valley Alta Vista to end of road Resident Only Parking – Mitigation measure approved; staff will be preparing the petition for community use.
- 2. Req: #2015-182: Encino Way (Encino Ave & Encino Way) Parking Issue
  Staff performed a site visit and stated that the street is a very small cul-de-sac with only
  5 houses. Painting the curb will result in no parking for residents. Staff will send a letter
  to residents to inquire about possible permit only parking.
- 3. Req: #2015-185: 646 N Canyon Blvd Restricted parking in front of residence
  Resident requesting restricted parking in front of residence. Field Services Manager to
  meet with the resident to discuss red curb in front of residence.

#### 6. Reg: #2015-193: Alta Vista & West Chestnut - 4 way stop

Request for 4 way stop at corner of Alta Vista and West Chestnut. Excessive speeding. Data Box confirmed that a stop warrant study was not warranted for this location. Staff to send letter to the resident to inform them of outcome of the data box placement.

# 7. Req: #2015-195: Olive and Primrose – Permit Parking only

Reviewing zoning regulations to determine if restricted parking is feasible. Staff to contact owner to determine number of units and available parking spots.

### 8. Req: #2015-196: 1805 Encino Ave - Speeding

Niles Boyer, Field Services Manager spoke with the resident and advised her that MUSD will not change the bus route. A suggestion was made to add a skip stripe to street. Work order was placed. Follow-up from Traffic Engineer to determine if skip stripe is acceptable. Further discussion needed on requested No Parking on west side of Encino from Genoa to El Dorado during school hours.

# 9. Req: #2015-197: Monrovia High School Area - Traffic/Parking

Staff to report on status of discussions with MUSD regarding handicapped parking request on Colorado and bus parking zone on Madison.

# 10. Reg: #2015-198: Duarte Rd West at Shamrock to California - Rear end collisions

Traffic Engineer to provide follow-up on Task Order for striping plan.

Resident Overnight Parking Only approved at the November 17, 2015 meeting. Staff installed signs. Staff to send letter to residents to inform them of the new parking restrictions.

# 13. Req: #2015-204: Genoa/Magnolia - Crosswalk

Resident requesting a crosswalk at the intersection of Genoa and Magnolia. Staff reported that the City Engineer does not recommend a crosswalk at this location. Staff to report feedback from discussion with resident.

#### 14. Req: #2015-205: Fano/Mayflower - Crosswalk

Resident requesting a crosswalk at the intersection of Fano and Mayflower. Staff reported that the City Engineer does not recommend a crosswalk at this location. Staff to report feedback from discussion with resident.

#### 15. Req: #2015-206: Corner of Olive & Gladys - No Parking Signs Removed

Resident requesting that the No Parking Signs on Gladys be removed to allow for additional on street parking. Staff to report on evaluation of street with regards to emergency vehicle access.

School requesting crosswalk at Jefferies & Rochelle. Area in question may be located in unincorporated section of Monrovia. Staff to evaluate and report on findings.

Resident stated trash cans are obstructing view of oncoming westbound traffic. Athens was contacted and trash can placement was moved. Resident still wants red curb on northwest side of property. Staff to report on evaluation of the area, specifically the visibility of west bound traffic.
